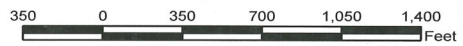

*c: Using Capabilities Class Dominant Condition Aggregation Method



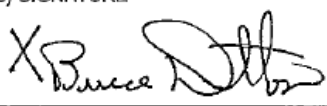

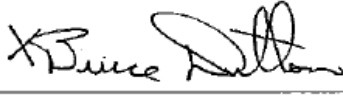
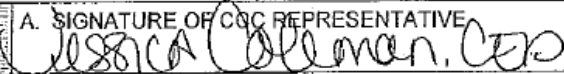
