Hampshire Haven Dedication of Plat and Declaration of Protective Covenants

KNOW ALL MEN F Y THESE PRESENTS: That the undersigned, Melbourne Properties, Inc., hereinafter re erred to as "Declarant" does hereby record the plat of a subdivision known as Hampslire Haven lying and being situated in Hampshire County, West Virginia, and being mor fully described on the plat and survey of Hampshire Haven and made a part hereof and recorded in the Clerk's Office of the Circuit Court of Hampshire County, West Virginia, contemporaneously with the recording of this instrument in which plat reference is hereby made.

All lots in Hampshire Taven Subdivision shall be subject to the following protective covenants, conditions, and restrictions and easements which shall run with the land and shall be binding upon all subsequent owners of the lots:

ARTICLE I DEFINITIONS

- "Association" shall m an and refer to Hampshire Haven Property Owners' Association, its successors and assigns.
- (2) "Owner" shall mean a d refer to the record owner, whether one or more persons or entities, of the fee s mple title to any lot which is a part of the property, including contract sell rs, but excluding those having such and interest merely as security for the perfon nance of an obligation.
- (3) "Property" shall mean and refer to any numbered or lettered plat of land shown upon the recorded sub-ivision plat of the property.
- (4) "Lot" shall mean and 1 : fer to any numbered or lettered plat of land shown upon the recorded subdivision plat of the property.
- (5) "Declarant" shall mear "Grantor/Developer" and refer to its successors and assigns.

ARTICLE II MEMBERSHI ', VOTING RIGHTS, AND OBJECTIVES

(1) Every owner of a lot, i cluding resubdivided lots shall be a member of the Hampshire Haven Proj erty Owners' Association. Membership shall be appurtenant to and may not be separated from ownership of any lot. There shall be two classes of mem ership, Class A and Class B. The Declarant shall be the Class A member and s all be entitled to three votes for every lot owned in Hampshire Haven. A lother property owners shall be Class B members and shall be entitled to one vote for each lot owned.

- (2) The Association shall be governed by a Board of Directors of not less than three (3) not more than Five (5) members. The Board of Directors shall be elected by the lot owners, except that the initial Board shall be appointed by the Declarant. The initial Board of D rectors shall be responsible for calling the first meeting of the Association to be led not later than January 31, 2003. The initial meeting of the members shall be led at a suitable place to be designated by the Board of Directors in Hampshii: County, West Virginia.
- (3) The Hampshire Haver Property Owners' Association, Inc. is required to secure and maintain a third perty liability insurance policy in the principal amount as may be required by the State of West Virginia or Federal law from time to time.
- (4) The Duties and Respo sibilities of the Property Owners' Association shall include, but not be lim ted to the following:
 - (A) Maintain Prop arty Owners' Association, periodically elect officers and directors, and stablish and collect fees and dues.
 - (B) Maintain Fina cial Records

(C) Administer the upkeep and improvements to the Hampshire Haven Subdivision.

ARTICLE III COVENAN' FOR MAINTENANCE ASSESSMENT

(1) Each owner of a Lot w thin Hampshire Haven shall pay an assessment for the reasonable constructio to use, and maintenance, and expansion of the roads and common areas. All as essments, including any pro-rate share of said assessments, shall be collected by and paid beginning the calendar year of January 1, 2003 through December 31, 2003. The Assessment for the calendar year 2003 and all years thereafter, unless amended pursuant to the terms and conditions of these constants, shall be \$100. In no event shall the annual average common expense liability of each Lot, exclusive of optional user fees adjusted, pursuant to the provisions of the West Virginia Code Section 36B-1-114, exceed \$300.00. All assessments shall be due and owing on the first day of January of each year and if unpaid shall be a lien upon the property against which each assessment is made. Nelbourne Properties, Inc. and its assigns shall have the right to sue for and collect any assessment, together with interest, properly assessed under this contract.

- (2) Any assessment made on a property pursuant to this paragraph including a late fee of Five Dollars (\$ i.00), interest at the rate of Ten Percent (10%) per annum from the date of delin juency, and reasonable attorney's fees incurred in the collection thereof, shell constitute a lien on this property until paid. This lien is expressly inferior and subordinate to any mortgage liens presently or hereafter encumbering the projectly affected by these protective covenants. The owner of each lot, by acceptance of a deed thereto, automatically becomes a member of the Hampshire Haven Pro perty Owners' Association to be created as herein set forth, and agrees to pay an a mount determined by the majority vote of the Owners of the Lots in Hampshire Haven Subdivision as deemed necessary for the purpose of Maintaining (includin; the removal of snow and the repairs and improvements of the roads and commo: areas) the right of ways and roadways and common areas as shown on the subdivision plat. During December of each year, beginning December, 2003 said Association shall notify each Lot Owner, in writing, as to the amount of the Lot Assessment which shall be due and payable in January of the following year. Ir the event of a resale of transfer of one or more Lots in said subdivision, this oblig ation shall run with the land and become the obligation of the new Owner(s) eve I though it may have been assessed to a prior owner.
- (3) If the owner of any Let is in default in the payment of any assessments, including interest and costs of cellection, in additional to any other means of collection, the Property Owners' Association may bring an action at law against the owner personally obligated to pay same.
- (4) In exchange for the Di clarant's agreement to install and maintain said roadways and rights of way until three (3) quarters of the Lots have been conveyed the Declarant shall be fore we exempt from the payment of said annual assessments and road maintenance ees as to all Lots now owned or later reacquired by the Declarant. In the even that the Declarant should later reacquire real estate through purchase at a preclosure sale or through settlement of an Owner's default in any contract note or deed of trust that the Owner should be obligated to pay the Declarant, Declarant shall not be required to pay any past due assessment that the previous owner may have owed the Association, nor shall the Declarant be required in the future to contribute to the maintenance of the roadways. Lot maintenance fee.
- (5) Each Lot Owner, by ac septance of a Deed thereto, acknowledges that the roads, rights of way, and com non areas are private in nature and shall not be maintained by the West Virginia E spartment of Transportation or other public agency and that the maintenance at d improvement thereof shall be the mutual obligation of the Landowners in the ubdivision abutting said roads and Common Areas.

ARTICLE IV USE RESTRICTIONS

- (1) No signs or advertisin; of any nature shall be erected or maintained on any lot, except for sale or rent 1 signs not to exceed six (6) square feet in area (said signs must comply with Hai apshire County Ordinances relating to the erection of signs), except for dire tional and informational signs provided by the Declarant.
- (2) No owner of any Lot: nall interfere with the natural drainage of surface water from such lot to the de riment of any other lots. Consequently, in the construction of drivew ups into any lot, a minimum twelve inch diameter culvert shall be used in constructing the driveway in order to facilitate natural drainage. No parking that obstructs traffic is permitted upon any road within the property, and as part of the development of any lot, the Owner shall provide adequate offroad parking for himse f and his guests.
- (3) Due to the unsightline s of junk vehicles, no motor vehicle or trailer which does not have current licens: plates or an inspection sticker not more than six months out of date shall be per nitted on any lot. Temporary camping trailers may be placed on any lot, prov ded they are in compliance with Hampshire County and West Virginia laws cor cerning temporary camping. Temporary camping shall be for no more than four 1 nonths at a time, and no more than six months per year, for the personal use of the owner and his immediate family.
- (4) No building of a tempo rary nature shall be erected or placed on any lot except those customarily erected in connection with building permanent structures, and in such cases, for a per od not to exceed twelve months.
- (5) Not more than one sing a family residence shall be erected on a lot of less than 20 acres. Not more than to a residences shall be erected on a lot of 20 acres or more. Residences shall contain a minimum of 1,000 square feet for a single story or ranch style residence and diaminimum of 1,400 square feet for a two story residence. Said square foot minimum is of living area, excluding basement, garage, porch, carport, leck and overhanging eaves. All exterior construction must be completed and closed in within 12 months of the commencement of construction. No externor siding of masonry block or cinderblock shall be permitted. Mobile Hor less are not permitted.
- (6) Each Lot shall be used or residential/recreational purposes only, and any garage, barn, or guest house mt at conform generally in appearance and material with any dwelling on said lot.

Notwithstanding the prior pa agraph, the following uses are permitted, subject to applicable state and local law:

(A) Home occupations conducted by the occupant.

- (B) Agricultural t ses, including incidental use and the construction of accessory bui dings connected with the agricultural use with the building of a residence including storage of temporary camping and lawn maintenance quipment. Said accessory buildings may be constructed before construction of the residence. Said accessory buildings shall not be used for te aporary sleeping or camping quarters.
- (C) Not more than one head of livestock per three (3) acres and one domesticated nimal (excluding dogs and cats) per five (5) acres shall be permitted per ot, unless otherwise approved by the Board of Directors of the Property (wners' Association, provided that no pigs or pig pens are allowed within the subdivision. All livestock must be fenced in. Operation of a 1y laying hen, broiler houses, or other poultry business is prohibited. L nited raising of poultry for personal use is permitted. Pets and domestics ed animals must be fenced in or otherwise prevented from roaming.
- (7) The owner shall maint in, repair and restore, as necessary, the exterior of any building or other impr vements erected on any lot owned by him. Owners likewise agree to repai and restore promptly to its prior condition any part of the subdivision road dama 3ed by equipment of Owner or his contractor enroute to or from Owner's lot. All lots improved or unimproved must be maintained by the Owner in a neat and or Jerly condition at all times. No garbage, trash, or inoperable vehicle or c her debris shall be permitted to accumulate or remain on any lot.
- (8) No building shall be en xted closer than twenty-five (25) feet from the property line, with the exception that where two or more lots are used together for the construction of one dw !lling, then the said twenty-five (25) foot setback shall apply only to the outsi e lines.
- (10) All sanitation facilitie constructed on any lot shall conform with the regulations of the West Virginia 5 tate Health Department, Hampshire County Health Department, and any ther government agency regulating the installation of sewage disposal syste 1s.
- (11) No lots shall be used comaintained as a dumping ground for rubbish. Trash, garbage, or other wast: must be kept in sanitary containers. All raw materials must be kept from vie v where possible.

- (12) The Declarant resen es unto himself or his assigns the right to erect, maintain, and operate and repl ce telephone and electric light poles, conduits, and related equipment and wate gas and sewer lines, and the right to grant easements or rights of way therefe 'e, over, on and under a strip on land twenty (20) feet along all of the right of we ys (and additional width as necessary for guying purposes), in addition to easem nts reserved by any other instruments duly recorded. Where the centerline of roadways or right of way serve as the property line of a lot, then the twenty ('0) foot wide easement herein otherwise reserved, shall exclude any portion of the lot included in the roadways or rights of way, and extend instead, acros the remainder of the lot bounding on said roadways or rights of way. Nothing here shall be construed as creating any duty of Declarant to install or maintain any utility services, however, as it is contemplated that actual installation wi be made at the expense of the utility and/or the lot owners. A \$2500.00 fee is to e collected upon purchase of the lot and held in escrow for the underground utili ies to be started no later than December 31, 2003. Lots I and 13 are exempt from the utility fee.
- (13) Each lot owner shall ave an unobstructed right of way and easement over and across the roads as shown on the subdivision plat as recorded from time to time, for the purpose of ingless and egress to and from the public roads and any common facilities in the subdivision. No part of any lot may be sold or used as a road or right of way to any land outside the Property without advanced written permission of the Declarant. The Property Owners' Association shall be solely responsible for the maintenance of the subdivision roads and common areas.
- (14) Reasonable cutting of wood and timber for land clearing is permitted. However, no cutting of wood fo commercial purposes is allowed.
- (15) If any lot owner shall violate any of the covenants herein, it shall be lawful for any other person, persons, legal entities owning real estate in the subdivision or the Hampshire Haven Property Owners' Association to prosecute any proceedings at law or no equity against the person or persons violating or attempting to violate any such covenant, either to prevent him from doing so or to recover damages or other dues for such violation. Failure to enforce any provision herein contained shall in no way be deemed a waiver of the right to do so hereafter.
- (16) The Association, by a rote of two-thirds (2/3rds) of its members, may make additional rules, cover ints, and restrictions for the use of the Property, which together with the abover may be deemed advisable by the Association.

ARTICLE V GENERAL PROVISIONS

- Declarant reserves the right to replat any unsold lot or lots. Nothing herein shall be construed to preve t Declarant from imposing additional covenants or restrictions on any un old lot(s).
- (2) In the event state, local government, and utility companies, or Declarant, requires the installation of a public utility system within the area of which the subdivision is a part, the grantee or grantees, by the acceptance of the deed, so hereby agree to pay their proportional share for the cost of erection, maintenance and operation thereof as determined by the above authority.
- (3) The Association or an 'Owner, shall have the right to enforce, by any proceedings at law or n equity, all restrictions, conditions, covenants, reservations, liens, and charges now or hereinafter imposed by the provision of this Declaration. Fail re by the Declarant or Association or by any owner to enforce any provision contained herein shall in no event be deemed a waiver of the right to do so there after.
- (4) Additional property m ybe annexed to the Subdivision by the Declarant.
- (5) Declarant reserves the ight to reasonably modify, change or waiver these covenants herein with ut the consent of any of the owners for a period of one year from the date of t e sale of the last lot by Declarant from Hampshire Haven.

ARITCLE VI

- (1) The covenants, restrict one and other provisions of this Declaration shall run with and bind the land for a period of twenty-five (25) years from the date this Declaration is recorded after which they shall be automatically extended for successive periods of to n (10) years. This Declaration may be amended during the first twenty-five (2:) year period by an instrument signed by not less than seventy-five (75) percent of the lot owners.
- (2) Invalidation of any of the covenants, restrictions, or other provisions of this Declaration by Judgement or Court Order shall in no way affect other provisions, which shall remain in fill force and effect.
- (3) Whenever in this Decla ation the context so requires, the masculine gender includes the feminine a d neuter and singular numbers include the plural and plural numbers include he singular.
