PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64178 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to U.S. Government, Winema National Forest of PO Box 1390, Klamath Falls, Oregon 97601, phone 882-7761, for the use of the waters of Crooked Creek, a tributary of Wood River, provided the total quantity diverted shall not exceed 2.0 \* for the PURPOSE of road construction and maintenance

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 27, 1982

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 910 feet South and 2800 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 12, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 12, Township 34 South, Range 7 1/2 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
