


#### VICINITY MAP I

The 202-mile long Saline River originates in the Ouachita Mountains and converges with the Ouachita River at the Felsenthal National Wildlife Refuge in Union County. The river is formed by four forks, the South Fork, the Middle Fork, the Alum Fork, and the North Fork, which all converge near Riverside in Saline County. The Saline is the last free-flowing river in the Ouachita basin, and three of its four forks are designated by the State of Arkansas as Extraordinary Resource Waterbodies (ERWs) meaning there are laws in place to preserve and protect them from actions such as damming and gravel mining that could be detrimental to the river.


The Saline River is known for its incredible water clarity and habitat quality. The river runs through dense forests which are home to many species of wildlife, and the river itself is home to a large variety of fish species, including different types of bass, crappie, catfish, and bluegills, among many others. The river has a gravel bottom and is relatively free of development. In addition to excellent fishing, the river provides wilderness floating, swimming, picknicking, and beautiful scenery.

The Saline River also has a history-rich background. There have been artifacts and relics found along the river from the Caddo tribe, and the Hughes mound located between Benton and Hot Springs is one of the largest burial grounds along the river. In addition to Native American history, the southern part of the river is associated with a rich French history, as many French natives settled along the banks of the Saline River in the late 1700s. This accounts for many of the French names found along the river. In the late 1800s and very early 1900s, there were 54 documented steamboats that traveled on the Saline River, transporting cotton, staves, and timber down the river each winter and spring.




# **AERIAL MAP**




