



# DESCRIPTION OF SURVEY OF 29.18 ACRES

This survey of a tract or parcel of land is situate along the east side of County Route 5/2, Old Jersey Mountain Road, in Gore District of Hampshire County, West Virginia, and is more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at a large marked white oak tree found on a point in the fence corner, said point a corner with the West Virginia Land Title Corporation and a corner of the Mill Mountain Subdivision, thence N 48°01'52" W, 1,271.08 feet to a steel stake found, a corner to David A. Mooreland's tract, said point further referenced as being S 47°28'49" E, 261.58 feet from a large marked white oak standing on the west bank of County Route 5/2, Old Jersey Mountain Road;

Thence with said tract N 42°43'33" E, 160.28 feet to a rebar and cap set at the base of a fence post found;

Thence N 36°49'39" W, 214.47 feet to a railroad spike driven flush on line in the driveway and being in the east right of way of the aforesaid road 15 feet from the centerline, continuing another 15 feet for a total distance of 229.47 feet to a point in the center of the aforesaid road;

Thence with said road N 52°34'03" E, 42.94 feet to a point;

Thence N 55°57'30" E, 89.19 feet to a point;

Thence N 59°46'05" E, 324.08 feet to a point;

Thence N 54°41'35" E, 76.34 feet to a point;

Thence N 45°09'35" E, 56.58 feet to a point;

Thence N 40°17'46" E, 61.43 feet to a point in the center of the road, said point referenced as being S 48°46'34" E, 25 feet from a rebar and cap found on line on the west side of the road in the original line of the Alexander tract;

Thence leaving the road S 48°46'34" E, 30.25 feet to a rebar and cap set on line with the Laurence R. Scates tract on the bank of the road approximately one foot west of the corner fence post, continuing same course, passing the division corner between Scates and Albert L. Thorp at 344.42 feet, continuing on same course another 1,202.96 feet for a total distance of 1,577.63 feet to a planted stone found on the northwest side of Solomon's Ridge, a corner with the Mill Mountain Orchard Subdivision;

Thence with said subdivision S 57°01'32" W, 891.40 feet to the BEGINNING, containing 29.18 acres, more or less, and is more fully shown on Plat of Survey dated March 31, 2004, attached hereto as a part of this description.
