Shockey, his wife, parties of the first part; and Jacob J. Guth and Barbara H. Guth, his wife, parties of the second part; and Clinton L. Ritter and Peggy L. Ritter, his wife, parties of the third part.

WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the sum of the Dollars (\$10.00), cash in hand paid, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of all of which is hereby acknowledged by the parties of the first part, the parties of the first part do hereby grant, sell, and convey, with general warranty of title, in fee simple, unto the parties of the second part, jointly as tenants by the entirety, with right of survivorship as at common law, all of the following described real estate, to-wit:

All of that certain tract or parcel of land, lying and being situate approximately 8 miles North of Gainesboro, Virginia, in Gainesboro Magisterial District, Frederick County, Virginia, being identified as Parcel 19, Ritter Mountain, Section IV, containing 5.23 acres, more or less, according to a plat and survey of Clinton L. Ritter, Land Surveyor, dated May, 1971, and being a portion of a 170 acre tract, which was conveyed to C. Max Shockey by deed of Merchants and Farmers Bank, Executor of the Estate of Hubert W. Shockey, Deceased and Margaret E. Shockey, widow, dated September 17, 1962, recorded in the Office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Frederick County, Virginia, in Deed Book 282, page 110. A reference is hereby made to the attached plat and survey of Clinton L. Ritter, Land Surveyor, for the descripton of Parcel 19, the property hereby conveyed.

This conveyance is hereby made subject to the restrictions, easements, and building lines of record, if any, affecting the aforesaid realty, and made subject to the following restrictions incorporated herein:

- No parcel or parcels of the real estate hereby conveyed by this deed may be subdivided into lots less than three (3) acres.

Ritter, his wife, parties of the third part, hereby join in this instrument for the purpose of releasing and quitclaiming all rights, title, and interest, if any, they might have in the herein described property, pursuant to a contract for the sale of land dated January 16, 1971, between C. Maxwell Shockey and Juanita N. Shockey, his wife, parties of the first part, and Clinton L. Ritter, and by any other means.

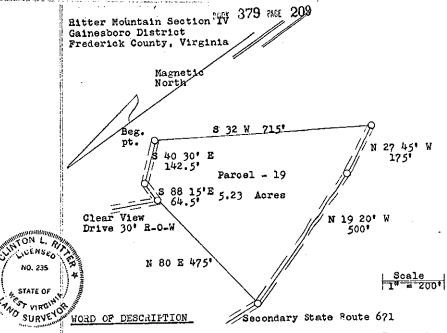
