LOCATION: Chilton County off CR 29 between Clanton and Thorsby

SIZE: 309 acres +/-

TERRAIN: Flat open pasture to gently rolling bottoms

LAND USE: Horse Trail Riding/ Hunting & Recreation/ Timber investment

HISTORY: Welcome to the Sullivan's at Evergreen, a multi-use recreational farm that is set up for equestrian trail riding, hunting, and timber investing. Privately owned and operated for over 38 years by the same family, the Sullivan's combined their passion of riding horseback and hunting into a tract that is like nothing else on the market today.

EQUESTRIAN USE: After purchasing the ideal property for their vision, the Sullivan's began hand cutting trails of various degrees of difficulty utilizing the land's terrain. Along the way the family took interest in the native flora and planted various fruit trees and flowering shrubs along the trails. The result is a first class horse trail riding facility that can accommodate riders of all skill levels with an emphasis on education. Along the 10+ miles of horse trails, riders will see plaques denoting different types of oaks and fruit trees including pears, persimmons, chestnuts, wild azaleas, crepe myrtles, mountain laurel and blueberry, raspberry, honeysuckle shrubs.


HUNTING: The property is also a well-managed recreational hunting property with many large green fields and six large shooting houses. An immaculate interior road system was built up, crowned and ditched allows access to all parts of the property. There are scores of wild turkey roosting in the large hardwoods along Eiland Branch, a winding creek that traverses the western edges of the property. There is also a 14 acre hay field that has hosted incredible dove hunts in the past. For those interested in quail hunting, there are several areas ideal for wing shooting on the property.


TIMBER: Another component to this unique investment is the beautiful timber the Sullivan's have cultivated. There are various ages of merchantable planted pine and hardwood in both the pulpwood log stages of maturity. The owner estimates a per acre value of \$600-\$800 which should be verified by interested parties through an independent cruise.




