## AEROBIC WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEM INSPECTION AGREEMENT

General: This Work for Hire Agreement (hereinafter referred to as "Agreement") is entered into by and between the above referenced home owner and BURGH SEPTIC and WASTEWATER SERVICES. By this agreement, BURGH SEPTIC and WASTEWATER and its employees (hereinafte referred to as "Contractor") agree to render services at the site address referenced above, as described herein, and the Customer agrees to fulfill his/her their responsibilities, as described herein.

Agreement Type: This is a variable agreement for a (5) year term, billable on an annual basis or by the inspection. Variable rate increases will be based on general cost of living increases and fuel prices and not to exceed an annual basis.

I. Renewal: This agreement shall automatically renew for an additional period of (2) years at the same terms, conditions, and costs, unless either party give notice of termination a minimum of thirty (30) days.

Termination of Agreement: This agreement may terminated by either party with (30) days written notice for any reason, including for example, substantial failure to perform in accordance with its terms, without fault or liability of the terminating party. Inspections: Contractor will:

A. Inspect and perform upkeep on the On-Site Sewage Facility (hereinafter referred to as OSSF) as recommended by the system manufacturer, and TCEQ and/or local permitting authorities for a total of (3) visits to site per year.

B. Provide written record of the visits to the site by means of an inspection tag attached to the control panel.

C. Repair or replace, if Contractor has necessary materials at site, any component of the OSSF found to be failing or inoperative during the course of: routine visit. If such services are not covered by warranty, and service costs are \$100.00 or less. Customer herby authorizes Contractor to perform the service for said service. When service costs are greater than \$100.00, or if Contractor does not have necessary supplies at the site. Contractor wil notify Customer of required service(s) and associated cost(s). Customer must notify Contractor of arrangements to effect repair of system within (2 business days after said notification, or Contractor will effect repairs and bill Customer for the service as required by State and/or local Agency rules

D. Forward copies of this agreement and all reports to the regulatory and the customer within 14 days.

- Visit site in response to Customer's request for unscheduled service within (48) hours of the date of notification of said request. Unless otherwise covered by warranty, costs for such unscheduled responses will be billed to Customer.
- I. Chlorination/Disinfection is required. The responsibility to maintain the disinfection device(s) and provide any necessary chemicals is that of the Customer.

II. Customer's Responsibilities: The Customer is responsible for each of the following:

A. Provide all necessary yard or lawn maintenance and the removal of all obstacles, including but not limited to dogs and other animals, vehicles, trees brush, or debris, as needed to allow the OSSF to function properly, and to allow Contractor safe and easy access to all parts of the OSSF.

B. Protect equipment from physical damage including but not limited to that damage caused by insects.

C. Notify Contractor immediately of any and all alarms, and/or any and all problems with, including failure of, the OSSF's.


D. Provide upon request by Contractor, water usage records for evaluation by Contractor as to the performance of the OSSF.

E. Allow for samples at both the inlet and outlet of the OSSF to be obtained by Contractor for the purpose of evaluating the OSSF's performance. I these samples are taken to a laboratory for testing, with the exception of the service provided under Section V. sub-section C. above, Customer agree to pay for sample collection and transportation, portal to portal, at a rate of \$75.00 per hour, plus the associated fees for laboratory testing.

Provide for pumping and cleaning of tanks and treatment units, when and as recommended by Contractor, at Customer's expense. F

Maintain site drainage to prevent adverse effects on the OSSF.

H. Pay promptly and fully, all Contractor's fees, bills, or invoices as described herein.
