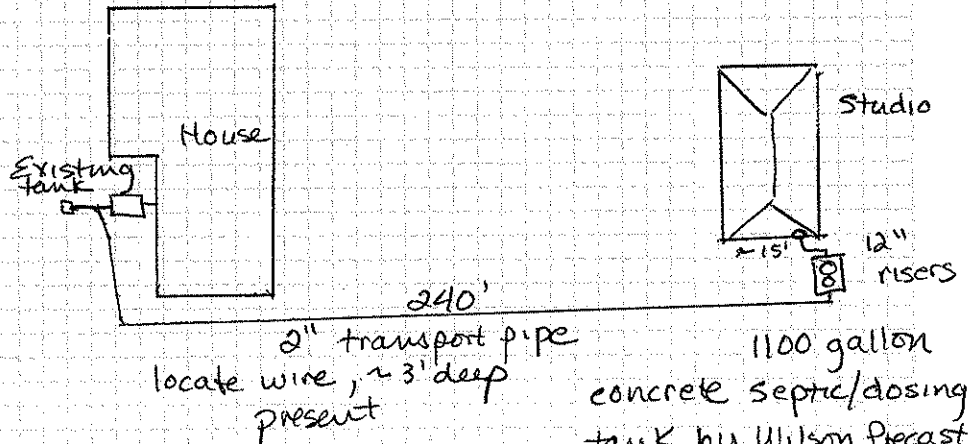

IMPORTANT DOCUMENT - SITE EVALUATION REPORT

Based on the soil profile in test holes you provided, the site is approved for a sewage disposal system. A copy of the study is attached and the requirements are as follows:

- Approved for an Alternative Bottomless Sand Filter System.
- Filter unit must be installed in the area shown on the back of the Site Evaluation field worksheet (attached).
- Filter unit and replacement area setbacks are 100 feet from all wells, and from springs located on property, and 10 feet from property lines.
- Any alteration of the natural conditions (i.e. cutting or filling) in the approval area or further partitioning or subdividing on the subject or adjacent properties may void this approval (ORS 454 and OAR 340).
- Sites for the initial and replacement Sand Filter units must be kept free from development.
- Due to the alternate design and cost of this system, a potential buyer should be shown a copy of this letter and attachments.
- Sand filter unit shall be installed on ground surface.

SAND FILTER UNIT SPECIFICATIONS

- Design flow: 450 gallons per day.
- Filter area: Minimum 366 square feet.
- Sand Criteria: Medium sand per OAR 340-71-290 (b) (enclosed).
- Bottom of filter unit shall be installed on ground surface.


Any person other than the property owner must be licensed by the DEQ to construct/install a sewage disposal system. A permit must be obtained from this office prior to installation. Submit the following items to obtain a permit:

1. An application signed by the Klamath County Planning Department for Land Use Compatibility approval.
2. Permit fee, \$305
3. A detailed plot plan.
4. Detailed plans which will be reviewed and approved by this department, must be of construction quality and include the hydraulic calculations for the pressurized distribution system. OAR 340-71-415, copy enclosed, gives you the ability to apply for a variance to the rules which may allow installation of a less expensive system. The cost of a Formal Rule Variance is \$225., with application and fee directed to the DEQ, On-Site Sewage Systems Section, Sherman Olson, 811 S.W. Sixth Avenue, Portland, OR 97204, phone (503) 229-6443. For your convenience I enclosed an application.



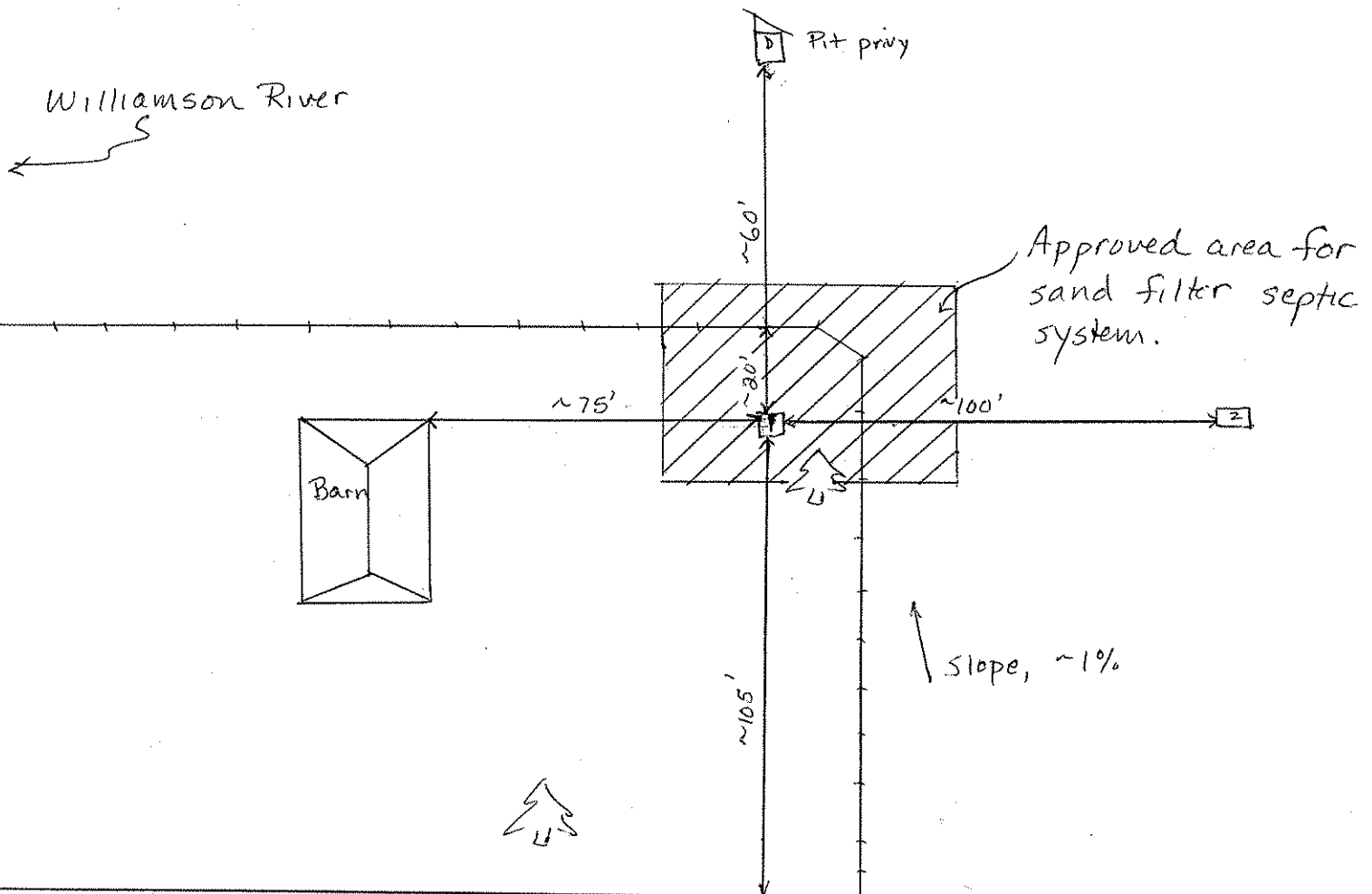

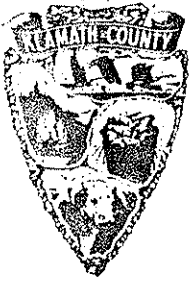

Authorization Notice

This notice authorizes connection of an additional bedroom and bathroom to the existing on-site sewage disposal system located on the above referenced property.

On April 30, 1992 this office conducted an on-site inspection of the subsurface sewage disposal system on the property referenced above.

A 1000 gallon steel septic tank was present. The tank was holding fluids and retaining solids. The representative of the property stated in the questionnaire that the septic tank had been pumped in March 1992. It is recommended that the septic tank be checked and pumped if needed every (4) years of use.

The tank was approximately 30 inches below the ground surface, and the lid was pitted with a few holes. We recommend the lid be replaced before covering the tank.

The exact amount, condition, construction quality or location of the drainfield was not disclosed and could not be determined. There was no evidence of surfacing sewage on the property. We can find no documentation of this system in our files.

This Notice does not guarantee satisfactory or continuous operation of the on-site system identified. Please be advised that should the system ever fail, prior to any repair work, a permit from this department is required. A permit and inspection of the building sewer connected to the on-site system may be required by the Klamath County Building Department.
