- 14. Remedies for misrepresentations or nondisclosure in a Property Condition Disclosure statement may be available to buyer and are set out fully in Tenn. Code Ann. § 66-5-208. Buyer should consult with an attorney regarding any such matters.
- 15. Representations in the Disclosure form are those of the sellers only, and not of any real estate licensec, although licensees are required to disclose to all parties adverse facts of which the licensee has actual knowledge or notice.
