Porter Ranch – Located on Highway 71

Built to Last! Hurricane & other safety features –

- 1. The house was raised 21 inches above grade which is equal to the old highway height.
- 2. The yard and the well house are also 21 inches above grade to insure that the well does not get contaminated by any standing water.
- 3. The water well at the pond is also raised 21 inches above grade level.
- 4. There are plywood pieces cut for each house window in the barn (hurricane protection)
- 5. There is a generator with specially designed hook up lines to connect to the refrigerator, freezer, TV, and water well (connections in the garage)
- 6. Surge protectors were installed by WCEC (Wharton County Electric Coop) to protect against power surges on all the wells, line coming into the house, telephones, gate opener, intercom, and TV's.
- 7. Hurricane Straps inside the attic secure the roof from high winds.

Additional safety features:

- 1. Alarm system, glass breakage alarm, motion detectors
- 2. Intercom system for the house
- 3. Built in safe.
- 4. Electronic gate with intercom system

Other specially designed features

- 1. House built with 2 x 6 (not 2 x 4) then 6 inches deep blown-in insulation to fill the walls. (See the total utility bills for June were approximately \$300 which included running the pumps to water the cows.
- 2. Double-pane windows
- 3. The raised house also sits on 40 pilings under the foundation.
- 4. House has Hague Water softener system and **reverse osmosis** system that goes to the ice maker and bar sink and refrigerator ice maker outside.
- 5. Designer kitchen drawers and pantry cabinets
- 6. Central vacuum
- 7. Copper pipes within the house are sleeved inside pvc pipe for added protection against leaks
- 8. Paved Asphalt road that runs entire length of ranch lined with live oak trees.
- 9. Large (approx. 2 acre pond with its own well, to keep catfish and cattle happy)
- 10. Cattle pens for loading and vaccinating, etc. built with EXTRA Large Posts
- 11. Two lockable barns with covered areas
- 12. Separate water well for the country house. (total of 3 water wells)
- 13. White decorative Vinyl fencing
- 14. Recently replaced all perimeter fencing of acreage and cross fencing
- 15. Approx. 80 Live oaks, pecan, and Elm Trees on the ranch,
- 16. Beautiful old country house for rental property that is secluded from main property
- 17. Aprox. 960 sq feet of tiled, covered porches, skylights on back porch too.
- 18. Sprinkler system with 11 circuits

***Additional 75 live oaks and water oaks were planted on top of a berm in 2012. An irrigation system was installed which waters each tree individually.
