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LOCATION: 400 West Parrot Creek Road, Roundup, Montana. Google says the property is 11 miles southeast of Roundup. The property lies in Parrot Creek Coulee surrounded by Ponderosa and rimrocks.

AREA FEATURES: The rolling hills and pines with outcropping rimrocks are on the property and throughout the Bull Mountains.

CLIMATE: Parrot Creek is in the 14—16 inch rainfall area and is moderate in snow-fall. The area is within the Chinook belt and has approximately 120 day growing season.

WATER: Parrot Creek is a seasonal creek and can't be depended upon. There are three wells listed, but only two are plumbed and in service. Well 1 is 100' deep and produces 40 gpm. Well 2 is 120' deep and produces 15 gpm.

IMPROVEMENTS: 1,008 sq. ft. ranch-style home on cement pad with pine interior. Use as either one bedroom with office or 2 bedrooms and 1 bath. There is gas (propane) heat and a large screened in porch.

Shop: Approximately 40' x 60' - split into two sides. Floor drain, insulated, heated, and cement floors.

Barn & Storage: 24' x 20', one half open. Barn and half enclosed and insulated. All cement floors.

Arena: 200' x 300' outdoor arena with steel fence. Cutting arena 100' diameter, assorted pens, and four acre steel fenced holding pen.
