



Topography through the ranch is rolling, sloping generally to a seasonal creek, known as Rough Creek, which runs through the central portion of the property. Hackberry trees and dense mesquite are common along the banks of Rough Creek providing excellent cover for wildlife. Overall, brush cover is dense throughout most of the property with thick mesquite and scattered cedar being common.

Two cultivated fields and several small foodplots are established on the ranch. The two fields measure just under 50 acres a piece.




The ranch is considered to be well watered. Five electric water wells are connected to pipelines that can distribute water throughout the property. These water wells are marginal by most standards, being just several gallons per minute each, however, in this area having a source of reliable water is a big bonus.

Besides seasonal water in Rough Creek, the ranch has four earthen ponds to provide water to wildlife and livestock. Some of these ponds have valved pipelines from the water wells that allow them to maintain a steady source of water.
