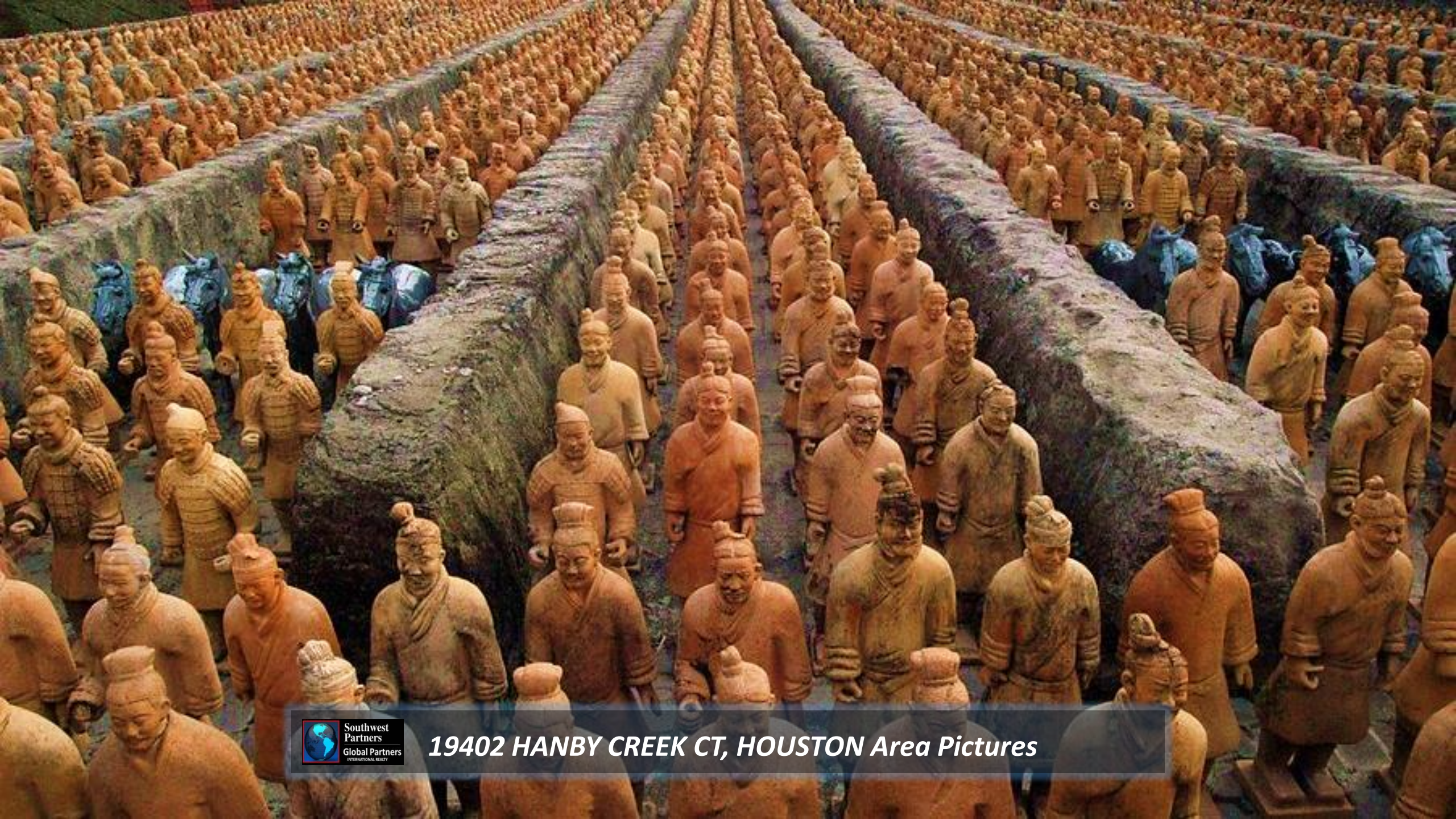

The Texas Western Narrow Gauge Railroad was chartered in 1875 by T.W. House, W.D. Cleveland, S.K. McIlhenny and Brown Botts, among others. It was the pioneer narrow gauge line in Texas. The depot was at Commerce and St. Emanuel. The track ran south on St. Emanuel and west along what is now Westheimer, through what is now Barker Reservoir to Pattison. It was projected to extend to the Pacific coast. The track reached Sealy in 1881 and never got any further. After a name change, a period in receivership and reorganization, the unprofitable line was bought by Colonel Elijah Smith of Oregon and abandoned in 1899.
