Beginning at a 1/2" iron rod set in the north line of said 29.9975 acres, in a south line of a tract deeded to Texas Intercorp, Volume 408, Page 853, that bears S71°15'49"W 349.58' from the north east corner of said 29.9975 acres, for the northeast corner of this;

Thence S18°48'07"E at 1836.94' passing a 1/2" iron rod set in a fence and continuing for a total of 1867.70' to a PK nail set in the approximate center of County Road 217;

Thence S71°17'09"W 349.85' to a PK nail set in the approximate center of County Road 217 for the southwest corner of this, being a corner of a tract in the Ballard Estate, described in deed to Rich Ballard, Volume 236, Page 809;

Thence N18°47'21"W at 28.82 passing a pipe fence comer and continuing for a total of 1867.57' to a pipe fence comer for the northwest comer of said 19.9975 acres, for the northwest comer of this, being a comer of said Ballard tract and being a comer of said Texas Intercorp tract;

Thence N71°15'49"E 349.43' to the place of beginning and containing 14.991 acres

The bearing origin for the above described tract is that of the east line of said 19.9975 acres, \$18°48'18"E.
