No building shall be erected, reconstructed or structurally altered to exceed in height the limits established and specified for the use and the district in which the building is located.

No building shall be erected, reconstructed or structurally altered in any manner which will encroach upon, or reduce in any manner, the yards, lot area per family, ground floor area of residential buildings or lot coverage regulations established and specified for the use and the district in which the building is located except as otherwise provided in this chapter.

■§ 156.061 LOTS.

Every building hereafter erected shall be located on a lot which fronts on a street or place.

§ 156.062 VEHICLE PARKING SPACE; LOADING AND UNLOADING BERTHS.

For every building hereafter erected, off-street parking space and loading and unloading berths shall be provided as hereinafter specified for the use to which the building is to be devoted.

AUTHORIZED USES AND REQUIREMENTS

§ 156.075 PRIMARY PERMITTED USES.

- (A) The primary uses permitted in the districts established by or under § <u>156.055</u> are shown in <u>Table 1</u>.
 - (B) Where the district column is marked with an "X" the use is permitted.
- (C) Where the district column is marked with an "S" the use may be permitted only as a special exception under §§ 156.090 or 156.091.
- (D) Where the district column is marked with "C" the use may be permitted only as a conditional use under §§ 156.095 through 156.096.
- (E) Any use permitted in the basic district shall also be permitted in the RO and HD Overlay Districts.
