BEGINNING at an iron rod found in the center of County Road 2850, at the SEC of said 68.935 acres, for the SEC of this tract;

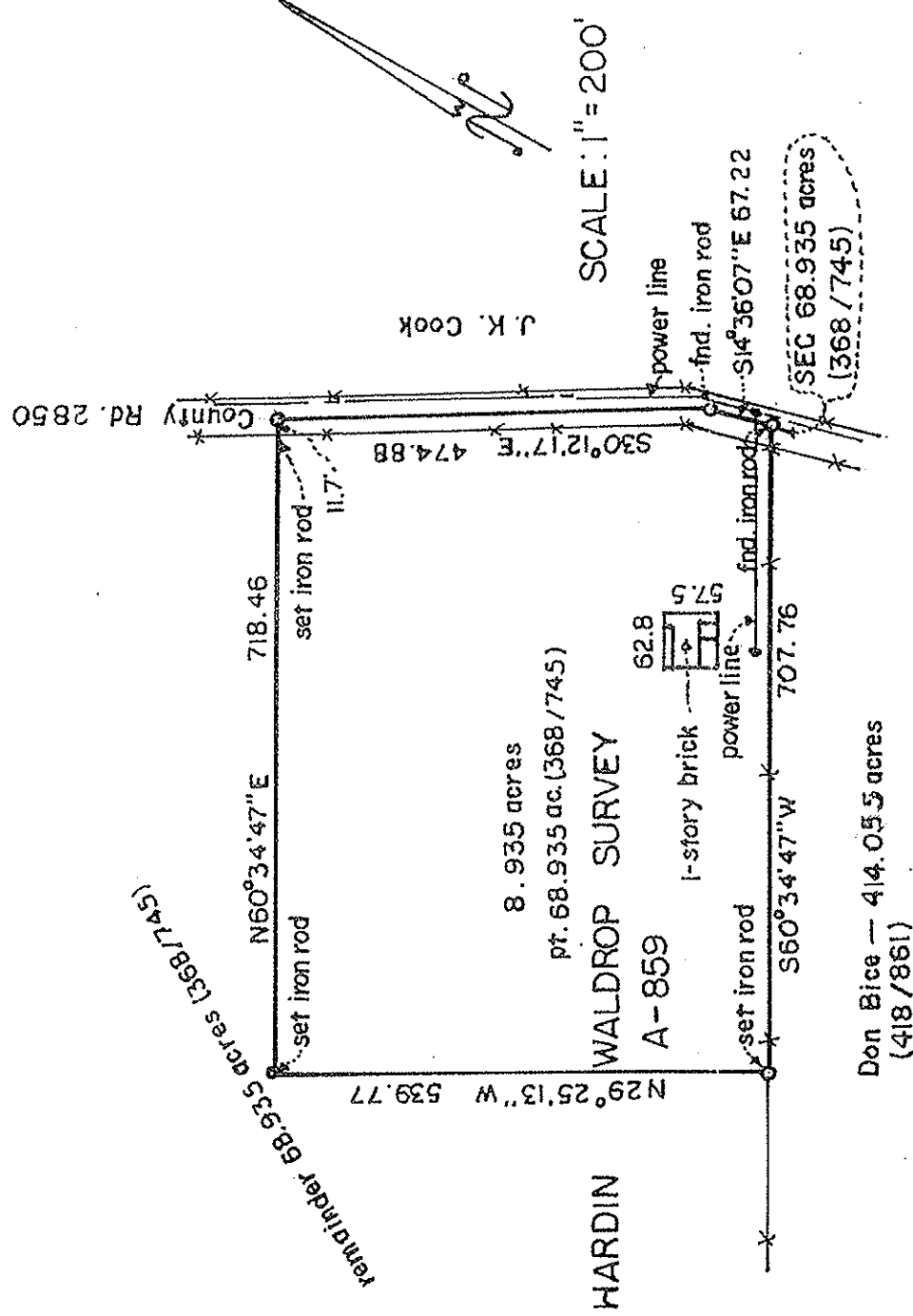

THENCE N. 29-25-13 W. 539.77 feet to an iron rod set at the NWC of this tract;

THENCE N. 60-34-47 E. 718.46 feet to a nail set in the center of County Road 2850 and in the east line of said 68.935 acres, for the NEC of this tract, from which point an iron rod brs. S. 60-34-47 W. 11.7 feet;

THENCE with the center of said County Road and the east line of said 68.935 acres as follows: S. 30-12-17 E. 474.88 feet to an iron rod (found); and S. 14-36-07 E. 67.22 feet to the place of beginning.
