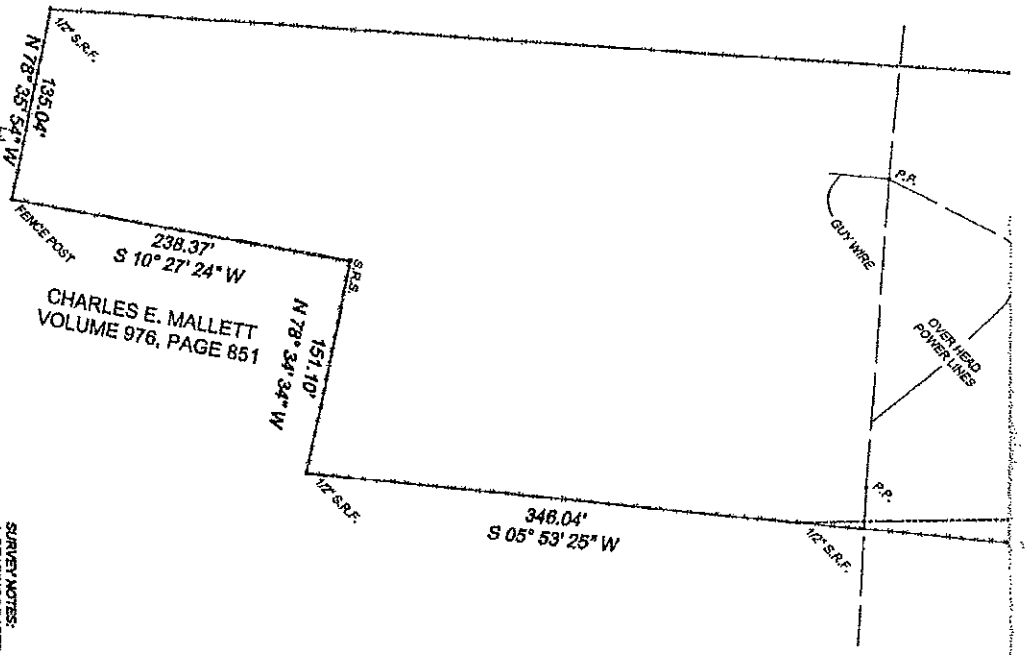

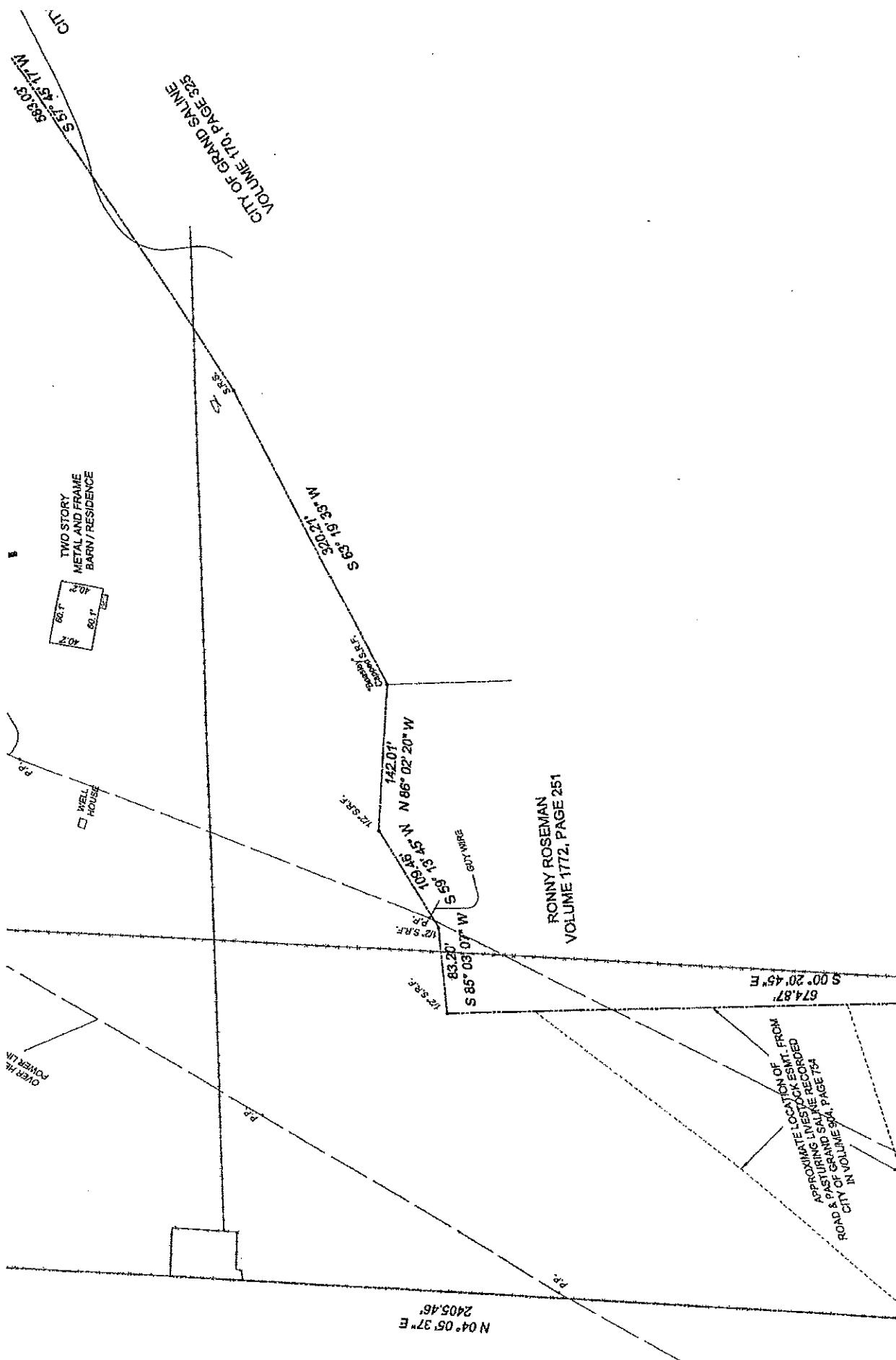

BEGINNING at a 10 inch fence post in the occupied North right-of-way line of U.S. Highway No. 80 for the Southwest corner of a called 1.00 acre tract of land to Charles E. Mallett in Volume 976, Page 851, Deed Records of Van Zandt County, Texas, same being the called most Southerly Southeast corner of said 47.92 acre tract of land;
THENCE North 78 degrees 35 minutes 54 seconds West, with the South line of said 47.92 acre tract and the North right-of-way line of said U.S. Highway No. 80, 135.04 feet to a 1/2 inch steel rod found for the Southeast corner of a called 102.0189 acre tract to Marilyn L. Richey in Volume 861, Page 1004, Deed Records of Van Zandt County, Texas;

THENCE North 04 degrees 05 minutes 37 seconds East, with the East line of said Richey tract, 2405.46 feet to a 5/8 inch steel rod set and capped "Vogt 5248" in the North line of said A. D. Benton Survey, Abstract No. 86 and the South line of a tract of land to Thomas N. Thompson in Volume 1155, Page 51, Deed Records of Van Zandt County, Texas;

THENCE South 87 degrees 10 minutes 37 seconds East, with the North line of said A. D. Benton Survey, Abstract No. 86 and the South line of said Thompson tract, 325.46 feet to a 1/2 inch steel rod found for the Northeast corner of said A. D. Benton Survey, Abstract No. 86, and being the called Northerly Northeast corner of said 47.92 acre tract of land;

THENCE South 04 degrees 37 minutes 32 seconds West, along the East line of said A. D. Benton Survey, Abstract No. 86 and the called East line of said 47.92 acre tract, 29.42 feet to a 1/2 inch steel rod found for corner;

THENCE South 55 degrees 54 minutes 19 seconds East, with the called Northeast line of said 47.92 acre tract and the South line of a tract of land to Johnny M. Thompson in Volume 1468, Page 935, Deed Records of Van Zandt County, Texas, 1157.62 feet to a 5/8 inch steel rod set and capped "Vogt 5248" for the called East corner of said 47.92 acre tract;

THENCE South 57 degrees 45 minutes 17 seconds West, with the called Southeast line of said 47.92 acre tract and the West line of a tract of land to the City of Grand Saline in Volume 170, Page 325, Deed Records of Van Zandt County, Texas, 583.03 feet to a 5/8 inch steel rod set and capped "Vogt 5248" for corner;

THENCE South 63 degrees 19 minutes 33 seconds West, continuing with the called Southeast line of said 47.92 acre tract and the West line of a tract of land to the City of Grand Saline in Volume 170, Page 325, Deed Records of Van Zandt County, Texas, 320.21 feet to a steel rod found capped "Beasley" for the Northeast corner of a tract of land to Romy Roseman in Volume 1772, Page 251, Deed Records of Van Zandt County, Texas,

THENCE North 86 degrees 02 minutes 02 seconds West, with the called Southeast line of said 47.92 acre tract and the North line of said Roseman tract, 142.01 feet to a 1/2 inch steel rod found for corner;

THENCE South 59 degrees 13 minutes 45 seconds West, continuing with the called Southeast line of said 47.92 acre tract and the North line of said Roseman tract, 109.46 feet to a 1/2 inch steel rod found for corner;

THENCE South 85 degrees 03 minutes 07 seconds West, continuing with the called Southeast line of said 47.92 acre tract and the North line of said Roseman tract, 83.20 feet to a 1/2 inch steel rod found for corner;

THENCE South 00 degrees 20 minutes 45 seconds East, with the called East line of said 47.92 acre tract and the West line of said Roseman tract, 674.87 feet to a 1/2 inch steel rod found for corner;

THENCE South 05 degrees 53 minutes 25 seconds West, with the called East line of said 47.92 acre tract and the West line of said Roseman tract, 346.04 feet to a 1/2 inch steel rod found for the Northeast corner of said Mallett tract;

THENCE North 78 degrees 34 minutes 34 seconds West, with the called Southeast line of said 47.92 acre tract and the North line of said Mallett tract, 151.10 feet to a 5/8 inch steel rod set and capped " Vogt 5248" for corner;

THENCE South 10 degrees 27 minutes 24 seconds West, with the called East line of said 47.92 acre tract and the West line of said Mallett tract, 238.37 feet to the Point of Beginning and containing 30.95 acres of land more or less.
