Simmerman and wife Audrey Simmerman to Nancy Meredith Hooker dated April 20, 1977 as shown of record in Volume 740-Page 453, Deed Records, Wood County Texas, said lot, tract, or parcel of land being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at a 1/2 inch iron rod found at the Northwest corner of said 25.192 acre tract and the Southwest corner of a called 25.192 acre tract described in a Deed from the Veteran Land Board of Texas to Donald Charles Wellman dated August 8, 2000 as shown of record in Volume 1740, Page 58, Real Property Records, Wood County, Texas, said POINT OF BEGINNING being in the West line of said Read Survey and being S 00° 07' W a distance of 503.6 feet from the called Northwest corner of said Read Survey;

THENCE N 89° 06' 41" E along the South line of said Wellman tract, a distance of 2179.59 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod found at the Southeast corner of said Wellman tract and the Northeast corner of said Spencer tract and in the West line of a called 60.27 acre tract described in a Deed from C. O. Noble & Melvin Langford to William M. Waggoner dated February 26, 1977 as shown of record in Volume 737, Page 861, Deed Records, Wood County, Texas;

THENCE S 00° 14' 19" E along the West line of said 60.27 acre tract and the East line of said 50.3 acre tract, at 267.90 feet passing through a 3/4 inch iron rod found, continuing along dsof line, in all, a total distance of 523.98 feet to 3/4 inch iron rod found at the Southeast corner of said *Spencer tract and said 50.3 acre tract and the Northeast corner of a called 24.977 acre tract described in a Deed from Loren T. Griswold & Bobbie Griswold to Valerie R. Luciana & Pete L. McFadden dated May 1, 2000 as shown of record in Volume 1723, Page 515, Real Property Records, Wood County, Texas;

THENCE N 89° 46' 31" W along the North line of said 24.977 acre tract and the South line of said 50.3 acre tract, a distance of 2175.65 feet to a 3/4 inch iron rod found at the Southwest corner of said Spencer tract and the Northwest corner of said 24.977 acre tract and in the called West line of said Read Survey;

THENCE N 01° 25' 26" W along said Survey line and the West line of said 50.3 acre tract, a distance of 255.91 feet to a 3/4 inch iron rod found at an angle point in said West line;

THENCE N 00° 07' 36" E continuing along the West line of said Read Survey and the West line of said 50.3 acre tract, a distance of 225.81 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING and containing 25.154 acres of land.
