From junction of Highways 27 and 301 in Murfreesboro, go north approximately 0.5 mile to curve. Turn left on Highway 19 across from Los Agaves Restaurant. At 4-way stop, go straight and drive west/ northwest on paved road 1.6 miles. Turn RIGHT (NORTH) onto Sour Springs Road (first road to right after crossing Little Missouri River bridge) and drive northwest 1.1 mile. Turn RIGHT (North) at intersecton and continue on gravel Sour Springs Road 2.5 miles north to gated road on right (east) White gate can be opened with combination of 5-7-5-7. Proceed east from gate 1.7 mile to KFS pink flagging at road, then turn left (East) 0.3 mile on unimproved road to purple gate at entrance of Boone tract.
