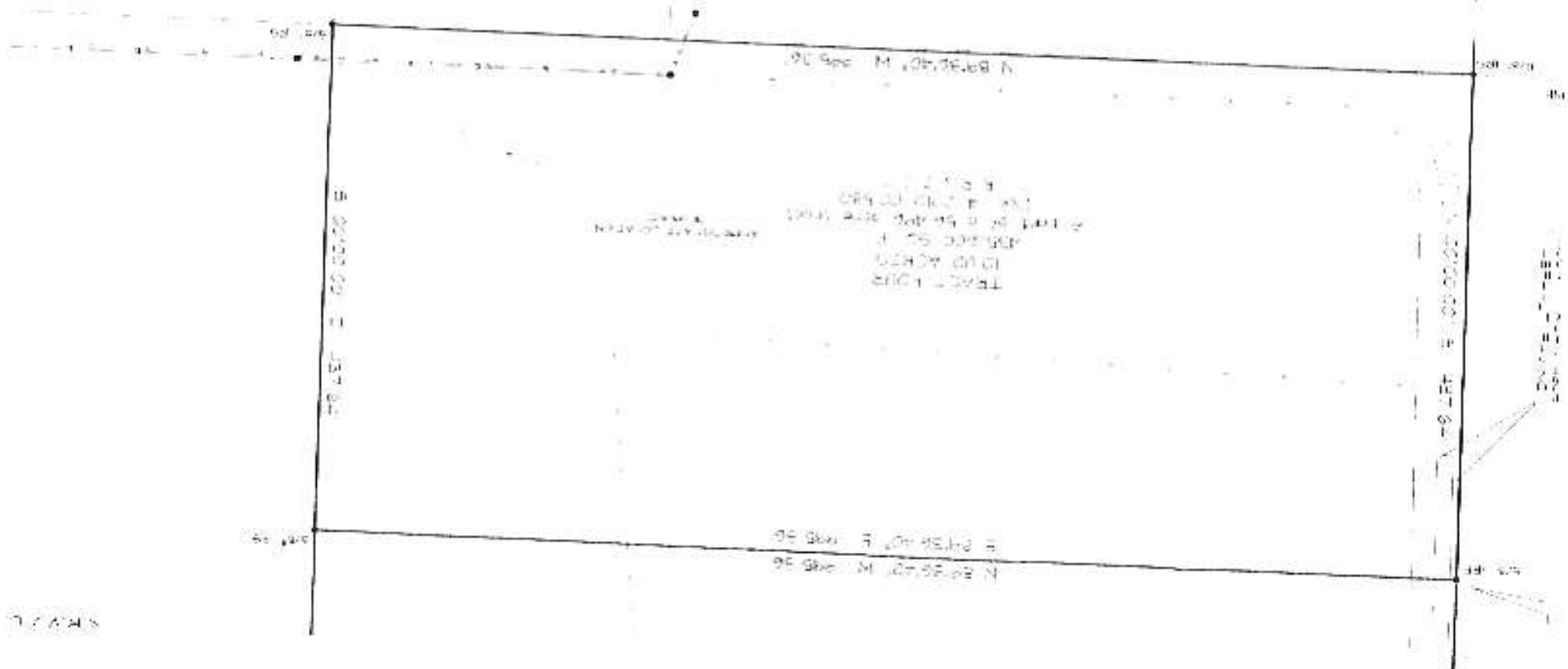

TRACT FOUR
METES AND BOUNDS

COUNTY OF VAN ZANDT

BEING part of that certain tract or parcel of land situated in the Thomas Horsley Survey, Abstract 341, and being part of a 56.496 acre tract of land described in a deed to Paul Mewbourn in Document Number 2010-001530 of the Real Records of Van Zandt County, Texas (R.R.V.Z.C.T.) and being more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at a 1/2" iron rod found for corner, from which a 5/8" iron rod found for reference bears South 40 degrees 29 minutes 15 seconds East, a distance of 2.45 feet, said 1/2" iron rod being the Northwest Corner of said 56.496 acre tract and being the Southwest corner of a called 26.54 acre tract of land described in a deed to Joe Charles Davis in Document Number 2008-007830 of the Real Records of Van Zandt County, Texas (R.R.V.Z.C.T.):

THENCE South along or near the West side of Van Zandt County Road 4905 and along the East line of a called 76.0 acre tract of land described in a deed to Kenneth Atteberry in Volume 505, Page 518 of the D.R.V.Z.C.T., a distance of 876.251 feet to a 5/8" iron rod set for the Northwest corner of the tract described herein and same being the POINT OF BEGINNING;

THENCE South 89 degrees 36 minutes 40 seconds East from the POINT OF BEGINNING, a distance of 995.36 feet to a 5/8" iron rod set for corner;

THENCE South, a distance of 437.64 feet to 60 "D" nail set for corner in or near said County Road 4905 from which a 60 "D" nail found for reference in or near the intersection of Van Zandt County Roads 4606 and 4905 bears South 89 degrees 36 minutes 40 seconds East, a distance of 888.12 feet, same being the Southeast corner of the aforementioned 56.496 acre tract;

THENCE North 89 degrees 36 minutes 40 seconds West along or near the said County Road 4905 and along the South line of the Thomas Horsley Survey, a distance of 294.90 feet to a 1/2" iron rod found for the common North corner of a called 25.75 acre tract of land situated in the Wm. Adams Survey, Abstract No. 6, described in a deed to Laube Robert John Jr. in Volume 2110, Page 168 of the D.R.V.Z.C.T. and a called 51.2 acre tract of land situated in the said Adams Survey described in a deed to Stanger Jack H. in Volume 1961, Page 384 of the D.R.V.Z.C.T., and continuing for a total distance of 995.36 feet to a 5/8" iron rod set, said 5/8" iron rod also being the Northwest corner of said 25.75 acre tract, and also being the Northeast Corner of a called 108.37 acre tract of land situated in the said Adams Survey, described in a deed to Shippey Earl G & Audrey D. 1993 Trust, and also being the common South corner of the aforementioned Atteberry and 56.496 acre tracts;

THENCE North along or near said County Road 4905 and along the East line of said Atteberry tract, a distance of 437.64 feet to the POINT OF

BEGINNING and containing a computed 435,600 square feet or 10.00 acres of land more or less.

**DEED RESTRICTIONS
EXHIBIT A**

1. No house trailers, mobile homes, modular homes, pre-fab homes, permanent R.V.'s, or temporary structures may be erected or moved onto any part of premises. All homes to be site built with 1600 square foot minimum air conditioned space with at least 75% exterior brick veneer.
2. All buildings or structures erected on any tract must be at dry-in within 6 months and completed within 12 months of ground breaking. All construction material shall be of new material.
3. ~~One farm animal per acre.~~ *PM*
4. No keeping any hogs, pigs, sheep, goats, dogs, and/or chickens for commercial use.
5. No noxious or offensive trade or activities will be permitted on this tract.
6. No inoperative or junk automobile, household appliance, rubbish, or anything of an unsightly nature will be kept on any tract.
7. All septic systems to meet county and/or state requirements.
8. Tract owner will be responsible for keeping tract mowed and maintained.
9. Only 1 home per lot
