



## FEMA Flood Zone Designations



- Zone A Areas with a 1% chance of flooding (inside the 100-year floodplain) and a 26% chance of flooding over the life of a 30-year mortgage.
- Zone AE, A2 Areas with a 1% chance of flooding (inside the 100-year floodplain) and a 26% chance of flooding over the life of a 30-year mortgage In most instances, base flood elevations may be available.
- Zone AH Areas with a 1% chance of flooding (inside the 100-year floodplain) and a 26% chance of flooding over the life of a 30-year mortgage. Base flood elevations derived from detailed analyses may be shown at selected intervals within these zones.
  - Zone AO, A4 River or stream flood hazard areas, and areas with a 1% or greater chance of shallow flooding each year, with an average depth ranging from 1 to 3 feet. These areas have a 26% chance of flooding over the life of a 30-year mortgage.
