Dear Sir:

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), proposes to construct the extension of Farm-to-Market (FM) 2110 along the approximate alignment of existing County Road 3375 in Houston County. The proposed project will provide two 11-foot-wide drive lanes and 4-foot-wide paved shoulders. This construction will take place from the end of existing FM 2110 to FM 1280 for a total project length of roughly 4.2 miles.

In order to complete the environmental studies for this project, TxDOT will need to conduct archeological studies on the existing and proposed right-of-way (ROW). Enclosed with this letter you will find two forms. The first form is a right-of-entry (ROE) form which grants TxDOT permission to enter said property to conduct these studies. On this form you may include special instructions. The second form is a transfer of ownership form which will give ownership of any artifacts uncovered by TxDOT to the State of Texas. For your convenience, I have enclosed a stamped self-addressed envelope for you to return the forms.
