HUNTING

Mule deer, turkey, bear, mountain lion and grouse thrive on the ranch's 400 acres and the adjoining Medicine Bow National Forest, but the ranch is best known for its trophy bull elk, some of which score 350 and better. Two landowner deer tags and two elk tags are included.





FISHING

Anglers will find ample action from the cutthroat and brown trout in three constructed ponds as well as in frontage on Box Elder Creek, plus an adjoining 1.5 miles of excellent stream fishing on state land.





LOCATION / IMPROVEMENTS

Good access (only about 45 minutes from Glenrock) and a well-built three-bedroom log cabin with running water, a generator, and propane make this a perfect hunting and fishing hideaway, whether you're relaxing for the weekend or an entire season.

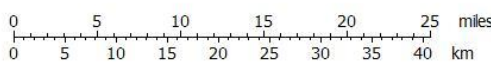




Fire Creek Canyon Ranch: Location Map
