
Located in the horseshow bend of the river this farm is 90% cropland and pasture with good fertility. The grain base has an annual value of approximately \$2000.

Quality Deer Management Practices





Aerial of Buckheaven Farm



The park boasts of some of the best recreation available and features a new \$2.5 million dollar conference center and a 18 hole golf course. With its stunning clear waters Dale Hollow is the perfect spot for scuba divers.





The historic Cumberland River winds nearly 700 miles from east to west, through a scenic region of rolling hills and forest. It makes its way down to Nashville, then back northwestward in to Kentucky to it's mouth on the Ohio River. About half of the river has been made navigable by a series of locks and dams. The trout and striper fishing are excellent in the Cumberland River.
