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Long Coulee Ranch

Wibaux, MT

Located 16.5 miles north of Wibaux, MT. The ranch consists of 4,480 deeded acres, 139 acres of which is CRP paying \$3,657/year.

Ranch also has 270 acres of tame grass and 80 acres of hay ground. Livestock are watered by 1 electric well that is 380 feet deep and supplies a pipeline with 10-12 water tanks, some solar wells, 4 windmills and a small reservoir plus 4 developed springs.

The present owner has been using the ranch for spring, summer and fall pasture and has been running 250 + pairs from May through December, cutting no hay. There is a small set of improvements including a 2 bedroom home, shop, barn and grain bins. This ranch is in excellent grass country and could be converted over to a year-round cow/calf operation.

Price \$4 Million.

The owner has 2 other ranches within a couple of miles of Long Coulee Ranch. The Golden Valley Ranch has 2,256 deeded acres in Montana and 1,937 deeded acres in North Dakota, of course the 2 pieces are contiguous and the Big Valley Ranch consisting of 6,700 acres and 1,760 acres State Lease. Both ranches have their own set of buildings and corrals as well as hay base. The 3 together would make quite a ranch located in extremely productive grass country and all well-watered.
