Jonesville, La., travel north approximately 2.25 miles. Turn west on LA 3101 and travel 1.7 miles to the fork in the road. Take the left fork headed south on Good Road. Follow Good Road for approximately 2 miles to the gated entrance located at the northeastern corner of the property.
