



7. J. & Audra Sine land.

DESCRIPTION OF SURVEY FOR KENNETH F. HAINES, SR. & MADGE L. HAINES

A tract of land known now as Parcel No. A located in Bloomery District, Hampshire County, West Virginia, on the southwest side of Gravel Lane (a 30' R/W) and on the northeast side of U.S. Rte. No. 50 about 0.10 mile southeast of the intersection of U.S. Rte. No. 50 with WV Sec. Rte. No. 50/26 (a 30' R/W) and is more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at (1), a WV Dept. of Highways 6" by 6" concrete monument, found, being at the west end of Gravel Lane and being a corner of the original 0.592 acre tract of which this survey is a part, and being a corner of Lot No. 28 of Hampshire Heights Subdivision Annex and owned now by Kenneth F. & Madge L. Haines; thence, going with the southwest bounds of Gravel Land for two lines, and going with the original for two lines,

FIRST COURSE, S 42 Degrees - 20 Minutes - 32 Seconds E, 118.82 feet to

(2), a 6 inch circular concrete monument, found; thence,

SECOND COURSE, S 42 Degrees - 25 Minutes - 01 Seconds E, 57.80 feet to

(3), a 6 inch circular concrete monument, found, in said bounds, being a corner now of Parcel No. B of 16,326 sq. ft. or 0.375 acres surveyed for Gay Shanholtz; thence, going across the original tract with a new division line, and going with Parcel No. B for one line,

THIRD COURSE, S 46 Degrees - 29 Minutes - 20 Seconds W, 73.30 feet to

(4), a flush 5/8 inch capped (Davy) iron rod, set, in the northeast bounds of U.S. Rte. No. 50 and in a line of the original tract; thence, leaving said Parcel B but going with the bounds of Rte. No. 50 for one line and going with the original tract for two lines,

FOURTH COURSE, N 31 Degrees - 03 Minutes - 48 Seconds W, 180.12 feet to

(5), a WV Dept. of Highways 6" by 6" concrete monument, found, in said road bounds, being a corner of the original tract and of said Lot No. 28; thence, with said Lot No. 28 for one line,

FIFTH COURSE, N 45 Degrees - 26 Minutes - 31 Seconds E, 38.01 feet to

THE POINT OF BEGINNING, CONTAINING 9795 SQUARE FEET OR 0.225 ACRE, MORE OR LESS.
