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#### PROPERTY DESCRIPTION

The subject property is shown on Caroline County Tax Map records as parcel number 64-A-22. According to the tax records the property contains 108.405 acres +/-. The original deed of the parent tract was recorded in Deed Book 163 on Page 12.

Known locally as the "Riverbend Farm," the subject property is located at the end of Shockey Lane. Its physical address is **20422 Shockey Lane**, **Beaverdam**, **VA 23015**. It is located about 3 miles southwest of Chilesburg. The subject property is currently zoned Rural Preservation (RP).

The subject property contains a 2-acre +/- home site, around 13 acres +/- of pastureland, and about 92.3 acres +/- of mixed woodland that was select cut 5 to 7 years ago. This select cut has left some scattered larger trees with a dense natural understory leading to the homesite.

The subject property boasts just over 2,000 feet of frontage on the North Anna River. There is also a 1.1-acre pond located along the property's western boundary and a perennial creek meanders along the eastern boundary into the North Anna River.

Per the county tax records, the 2,152-square foot brick Rancher (c. 1970) features 9 total rooms, 2 full bedrooms, 2.5 bathrooms, formal living room with fireplace, large family room/den, dining area, kitchen, large walk-in closet off the master bedroom, large Florida room and a split basement measuring around 1,140 square feet. There is a 16'x16' rear deck and breezeway leading to a 2-car detached brick garage with rear deck. Other noteworthy features include an emergency whole-house generator, a geothermal water furnace, an in-ground pool and a partially paved driveway leading to the house.

Per the county tax records, the subject property's other improvements include a 22'x52' framed garage with attached shop, a 24'x'30 pole barn and a 30'x30' trapezoid barn.








