FIELD NOTES

Being all that certain lot, tract, or parcel of land, lying and being situate in the County of Van Zandt, State of Texas, a part of the A. Parham Survey, Abstract No. 666, and more fully described as follows, to-wit:

Being a part of a certain tract called 80 acres, more of less, in deed from 0. W. Henry to Ben R. Buford, dated August 30, 1963, and now of record in Vol. 571, at Page 412, Deed Records of Van Zandt County, Texas,

BEGINNING at an iron bar set for corner in South line of a certain tract called 8.88 acres in deed from Ben R. Buford to W. T. Henry, dated November 20, 1963, and now of record in Vol. 572, at Page 218, Deed Records of Van Zandt County, Texas, and 15.57 feet North 89 deg. 6 min. West from the Southeast corner of said 8.88 acre tract, which said Southeast corner is 1290.82 feet South 0 deg. 48 min. West from the original Northeast corner of said 80 acre tract;

THENCE North 89 deg. 6 min. West, following said South line of 8.88 acre tract, 417.43 feet to iron bar set for corner;

THENCE South 0 deg. 48 min. West 208.71 feet to iron bar set for corner;

THENCE South 89 deg. 6 min. East 417.43 feet to iron bar set for corner in fence along West line of a community road;

THENCE North 0 deg. 48 min. East, following said fence along West line of road, 208.71 feet to the place of beginning, containing 2 acres of land.
