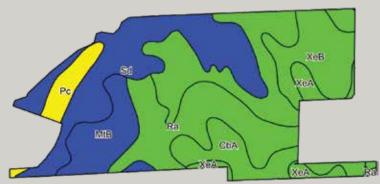

* The Palms Muck soil on the farm is classified as undrained by the NRCS, so it lacks a corn and soybean productivity rating in the table to the left. However, this area of the farm had tile installed in it to drain it in 2008. Therefore, it is more representative of a Palms Muck, drained soil classification, which has productivity ratings of 160 and 42 for corn and soybeans respectively. This would raise the overall Weighted Averages on the farm to 157.2 and 48.9 for corn and soybeans respectively.

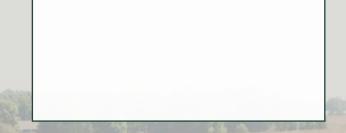

ACREAGE: The acreages listed in this brochure are estimates taken from the county assessor's records, FSA records and/or aerial photos.

SURVEY: The Sellers reserve the right to determine the need for and type of survey provided. A new survey will be completed, the cost of which will be shared 50/50 by the Sellers and the Buyer(s). The Sellers will choose the type of survey to be completed and warrant that it will be sufficient to provide an owner's title insurance policy for the tract.
