Thence east 299 links to beginning.

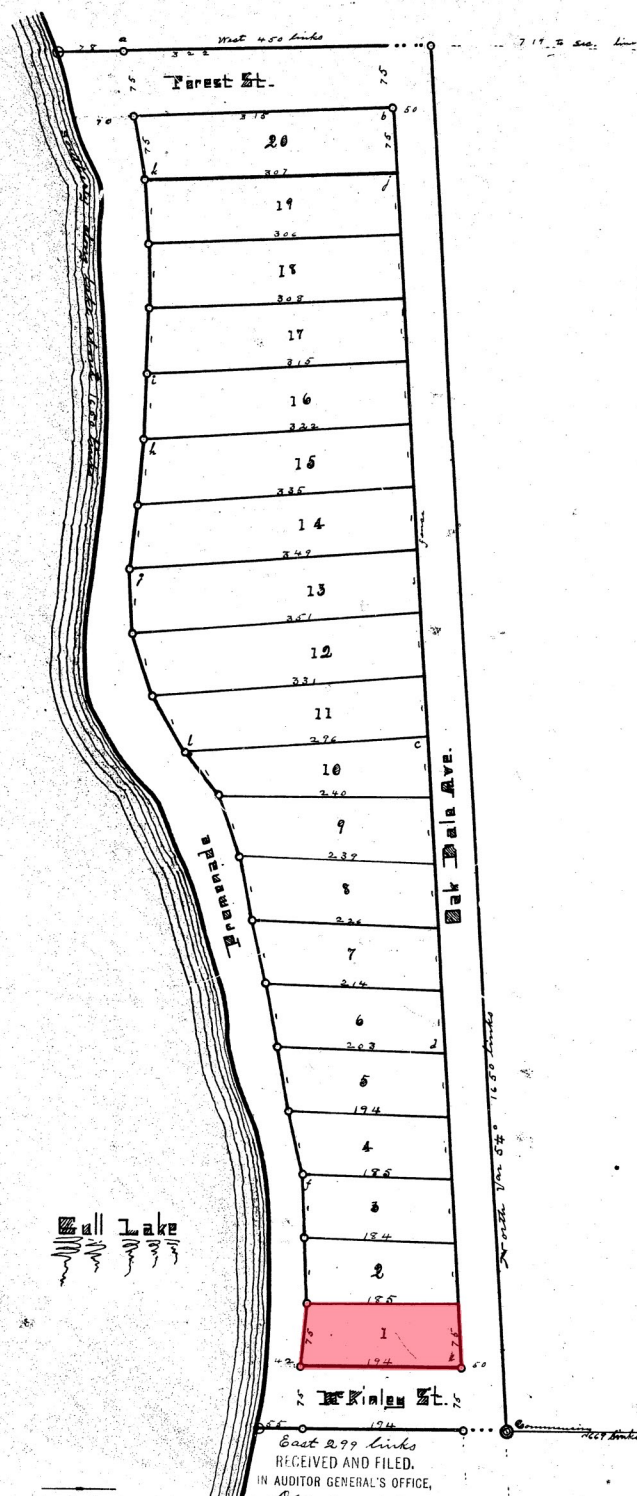
