Located in the heart of town, yet it sits on 11 ½ riverbank acres of remarkable deer refuge or bow hunting.

Separate garage

Separate workshop with 1930's streetlight attached, original to the site.

Huge trees

Old-fashioned irises all over the big yard

Awarded "Yard of the Month" in January 2018

Needs new wallpaper and new ceiling fans.

In the upstairs one room has a room air conditioner and another has a window unit air conditioner. A wall heater warms the upstairs.

2,500 bluebonnet seeds were planted in the big east yard in the area near the street 2 years ago. We are told that they don't bloom until the third year.
