

## AGREEMENT

It is agreed by Kenneth L. Boober and Geraldine Boober both of Orland, Hancock County, Maine, and Edith O. Tunison of the City, County, and State of New York, as follows:

That the dividing boundary lines between the property of Edith O. Tunison and the property of Kenneth L. and Geraldine Boober, adjoining, is hereby established as follows:

Said Tunison's Northerly and Westerly lines of her property and the Southerly and Easterly lines of said Boober's property (adjoining premises) are hereby established to read as follows:

Beginning at the southwestern end of First Toddy Pond, so called, located in East Orland, Maine, at an iron post driven into the shore of said pond near the western end of a sand beach, said iron post being about 2½ rods easterly from the mouth of a small spring-fed brook; thence about south 3 degrees east for a distance of about 5 rods and 4 feet following an old wire fence to an iron post driven into the ground near the center of a small ridge; thence about south 88 degrees west following an old wire fence and the remains of an old cedar rail fence for a distance of 155 rods, more or less, to an iron post driven into the ground at the eastern side of the so called Back Ridge Road. Line trees are blazed on east and south sides and painted with yellow paint.
