



**From Hwy 218:** Four miles south of La Porte City, turn west onto  $53^{rd}$  St. Continue west on  $53^{rd}$  St for 3.0 miles. Turn right onto  $12^{th}$  Ave/Cotter Rd. Head north for one half mile. The property will be on your left.

From Hwy 21: Six miles east of Traer, turn north onto IA-21 N. Continue on IA-21 N for 5.4 miles before turning right (east) onto 130<sup>th</sup> St. Then turn right onto Hwy V37/Y Ave. Then left onto 53<sup>rd</sup> St Dr. 53<sup>rd</sup> St Dr. turns left and becomes 11<sup>th</sup> Ave. Turn right onto 53<sup>rd</sup> St. Turn left onto 12<sup>th</sup> Ave/Cotter Rd. The property will be on your left.
