

## **METES & BOUNDS DESCRIPTION**

OF A 54.99 ACRE (CALLED 54.80 ACRE) TRACT OF LAND OUT OF THE E. MEDA SURVEY NO. 201, ABSTRACT 224, GUADALUPE COUNTY, TEXAS, BEING PART OF SHARE 4 AND SHARE 5, AS DESCRIBED AND PLATTED IN PARTITION DEED DATED JANUARY 25, 1955, EXECUTED BY W.L. SINGLETARY ET AL, AND BEING RECORDED IN VOLUME 390, PAGES 119-128, DEED RECORDS OF GUADALUPE COUNTY, TEXAS, BEING THE SAME TRACT OF LAND AS CONVEYED TO STEVE FENDER IN VOLUME 2842, PAGE 39, OFFICIAL PUBLIC RECORDS OF GUADALUPE COUNTY, TEXAS, SAID TRACT BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

**BEGINNING** at a found 1/2" iron rod in the westerly R.O.W. line of Sweet Home Rd. (A.K.A., County Road 409, per deed Stein Mill Olmos Road, an 80' Public R.O.W.) for the southeast corner of the herein described tract, the northeast corner of the remaining portion of called 24.87 acre tract conveyed to Steve Fender and Becky Fender in Vol. 3066, Pg. 279, Official Public Records of Guadalupe County, Texas;

**THENCE** leaving said R.O.W., along and with the north boundary line of said Fender Tract, generally along a fence, South 89°51'07" West, a distance of 2527.72 feet (called North 88°45'00" West, a distance of 2528.60 feet) to a found 1/2" iron rod for the southwest corner of the herein described tract, the southeast corner of the Estate of C.A. Phillips Tract, the northeast corner of the Elizabeth Jandt and John Jandt Tract;

**THENCE** generally along a fence, along and with the east boundary line of said Phillips Tract, North 00°52'03" West, a distance of 975.38 feet (called North 00°36'00" East, a distance of 969.40 feet) to a found 5/8" iron rod for the northwest corner of the herein described tract, the northeast corner of said Phillips Tract, a point in the south boundary line of a called 33.33 acre tract conveyed to Brian K. Hunter and Donna K. Hunter in Vol. 1979, Pg. 153, Official Public Records of Guadalupe County, Texas;

**THENCE** along and with said boundary, South 89°16'01" East, a distance of 1277.70 feet (called South 87°59'00" East, a distance of 1277.70 feet) to a set 1/2" iron rod for the northwest corner of a called 1.13 acre tract conveyed to Katherline L. Singletary in Vol. 285, Pg. 601, Official Public Records of Guadalupe County, Texas;

**THENCE** along and with the west boundary of said Singletary Tract, South 00°10'01" East, a distance of 38.40 feet (called South 01°07'00" West, a distance of 38.40 feet) to a set 1/2" iron rod for the southwest corner of said Singletary Tract, an angle point of the herein described tract;

**THENCE** along and with the south boundary of said Singletary Tract, North 89°04'27" East, a distance of 1260.74 feet (called South 89°41'00" East, a distance of 1259.90 feet) to a set 1/2" iron rod for the northeast corner of the herein described tract, the southeast corner of said Singletary Tract, a point in the westerly R.O.W. line of said Sweet Home Rd.;

**THENCE** along and with said R.O.W., South 00°15'25" East, a distance of 934.37 feet (called South 01°07'00" West, a distance of 934.40 feet) to the **POINT OF BEGINNING** and containing 54.99 acres, more or less.
