PROPERTY DESCRIPTION

The subject property is shown on Caroline County Tax Map records as parcel number 77-A-24. According to the tax records, the subject property contains 90.4 acres; however, the deed and old plat describe the property as 145 Acres, more or less. **Our GIS representation of the subject property based on the timber harvest boundary lines calculates to around 105 Acres** +/-. A recent deed is recorded in Deed Book 1060 on Page 937. An old 1893 plat completed by E. B. Travis, Surveyor, was recorded in Deed Book 80 on Page 126. A review of the Caroline County Tax Records indicates the following:

The subject property is currently zoned Rural Preservation (RP). The subject property contains no state road frontage. Access appears to be a prescriptive easement over the existing woods road from Passing Road (State Route 625) over a distance of about 2.4 miles +/- to the subject property. The 1893 plat shows double lines located between Point A and Point B on the eastside of Lot 7 (19.5 acres +/-) to the subject property from the woods road which may be the historical access road into the subject property.

The subject property was completely cut-over in 2014 and has been left to naturally regenerate in pines. There is around 6.2 acres +/- located in the swamp along the subject property's southern boundary per the subject's GIS tax map shape.












TAX MAP
