or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SWM NWM, Section 17, T. 40 S., R. 19 E., W. M. Diversion point located: 130 feet North and 2730 feet East from Center, Section 18.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 21/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


