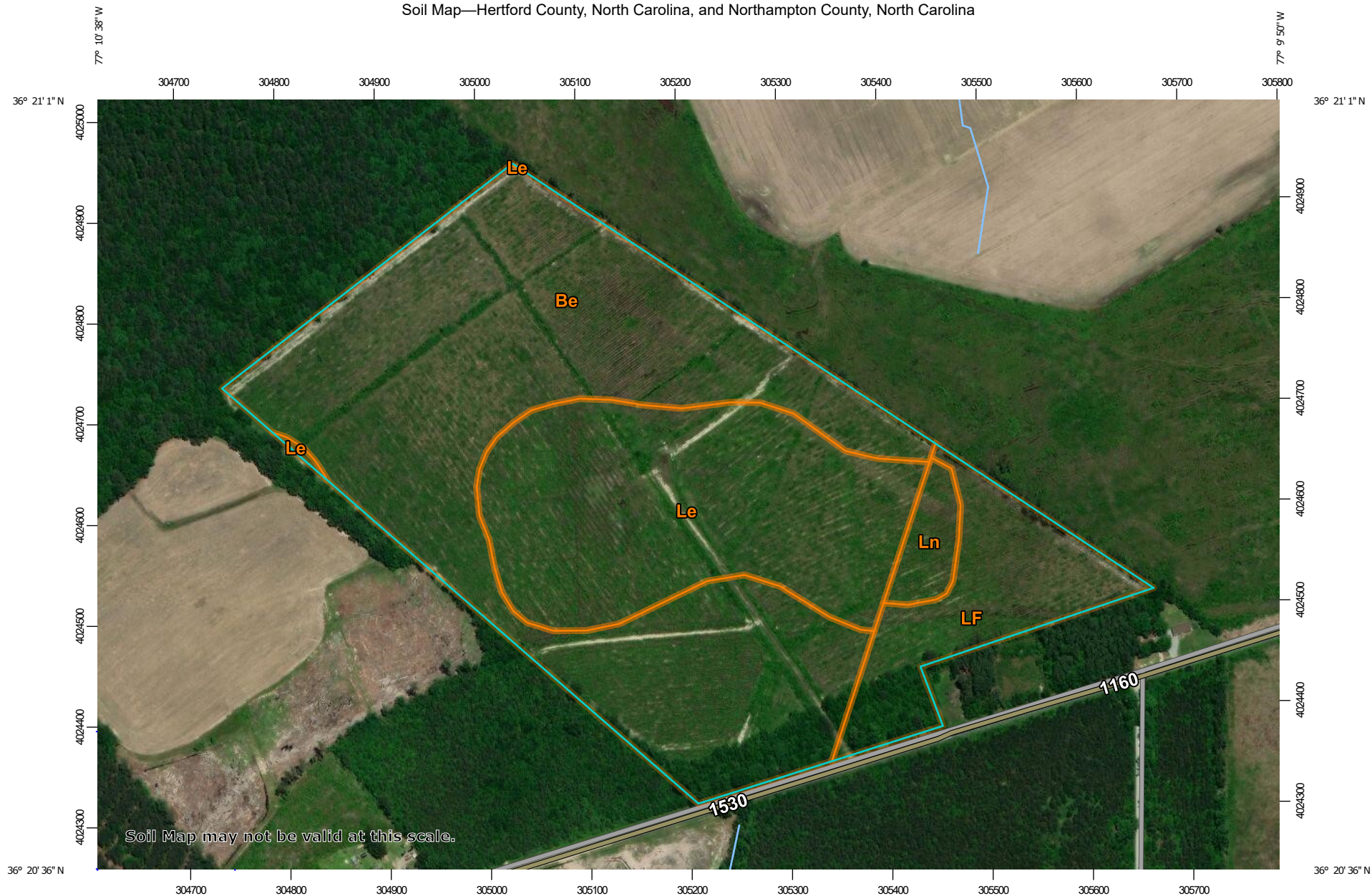


# Soil Map—Hertford County, North Carolina, and Northampton County, North Carolina
