The well was drilled in 2019 to a depth of approximately 395± feet and has a 15hp submersible pump. The ranch can be irrigated in three sets. There is also a domestic L.S.I.D. meter for the mobile home.

There are two wind machines. One is a 2014 Orchard Rite diesel wind machine and the other is an older EOT wind machine.

There is a 1,400±sq ft mobile home located on the property that is on a permanent foundation. The home was built in 2011 and features 3 bedrooms and 2 bathrooms.


**SOILS:**


The asking price is \$1,200,000. The seller is to be granted a long term lease for the mobile home.
