Oct 27, 1793 Commonwealth of Virginia to Charles Lee
No local record

**** log structure built during this time**

Jul 13, 1799 Charles Lee sold to James M. Marshal for one cent
- recorded on Oct 14, 1799
- all that tract or parcel of land granted by the Commonwealth of Virginia to Charles Lee by _____, date Oct 27, 1793 laying in the county of Hampshire adjoining the lot laid off for a courthouse in the now town of Romney.

Aug 14, 1799 James M. Marshall sold to Sir Peyton Shipwith (sp) for \$100
- 340 acres near Romney In Hampshire County

Jan 9, 1809 Jane Shipwirth (sp), widow of Sir Peyton Shipwirth sold to William Naylor \$100
- 340 acres near Romney in Hampshire county

Oct 16, 1847 Susan Naylor, widow of William Naylor sold to Alfred P. White for \$200 current money of the United States
- a certain lot or parcel of land adjoining at the corner of the stables on the lot sold to Nathnal Kuykendall, on the alley then with the alley to the Northwestern Turnpike road, thence with NWT road one hndread and 36 ft, 3 in to a stake , than a line parallel with the alley to Kuykendall's and then with Kuykendall's line to the beginning containing 1 acre of land more or less, the said lot being part of the meadow lot.....

**** sometime during the above period the front of the house was added.**

Nov 5, 1863 Alfred P. White (used as a law office) sold to Dr Samuel R Lupton for \$975

**** in local newspapers, used as a doctor's office and a hospital during the Civil War**

Jul 18, 1895 H.B. Gilkeson, attorney assigned as special commission to sell property for Patty P Lupton, widow of Dr Sameuel Lupton, George F., Charles H. and Kate (Lupton) Shaffer.

Jul 30, 1901 H.B. Gildeson, special commission sold to Samuel H. Williams for \$1363.07

Aug 5, 1903 Samuel H. Williams sold to Ray M. Busler For \$2600
- situated east of an near the town of Romney, WV, north side of the Northwesterngrade.

Nov 3, 1910 Ray M. Busler sold to M.H. Taylor for \$3800
- real estate situated east of and now within the corporate limits of Romney, WV, commonly known as the Lupton Property

Jun 10, 1912 M.H. Taylor sold to Sallie C. Ailes for \$10 cash in hand
- situated in the town of Romney, commonly known as the Lupton property

Jun 13, 1916 Sallie C. Ailes and husband sold to George Billmyre for \$3750

Jul 1, 1940 Rosa Billmyre, widow of George Billmyre, sold to John D. Blue for \$2000
