Lower garden is no dig approach based on Charles Dowding's method. All newly established (4/21) beds are pure compost. The compost will be good for 5 years of harvest without needing amendments.

Upper garden is raised beds with Megan Mix from Cattlepoint Topsoil. 60/40 compost and topsoil beds enhanced with humus amendment.
