

The Saline River Retreat is an outstanding and rare opportunity as a family retreat or as a residential development investment. The property consists of 543.48 (+/-) acres of timberland with over a half mile of frontage along the Saline River, located in Saline County, Arkansas. The river frontage offers incredible elevated views from the mountain tops, and river valley access for fishing, boating, and swimming. There are several areas within the property boundaries that feature topographic elevations that would be conducive to small lake development. The merchantable timber on the property is in good health and ranges from monolific planted pine to mixed uneven aged hardwoods. The property has been developed for wildlife with food plots planted annually, and openings and roadways maintained. Access is great from W. Jackman Trail, and the property has municipal water extended within.

The Saline River Retreat has great potential for residential development, with quick access to Interstate 30, close proximity to the town of Benton, and is located within the highly-rated Benton School District.





AERIAL MAP I







AERIAL MAP II




















