This also provided a location for the Providence Schools to play matches and eventually led to the acquiring and remodeling of the same building into a warehouse gym. Also, under the ownership of Mr. Verboom were the celebrated "Cowboy Sunday" - a bluegrass event the Verboon family used to put on at the property that held anywhere from 400-1000 attendees. In November of 1946, The Verboom family left war-torn Holland and immigrated to the U.S. in a cargo ship, which traveled across the Atlantic through the Panama Canal and arrived in San Pedro, CA in January of 1947 with very few belongings to their family name. The journal his father recorded gave us insight into the daily life of 49 days on a cargo ship.

In Southern California, the Verboom family moved five different times. They started their first dairy in Norwalk. Buena Pack is where they bought their next dairy. The last dairy in Southern California was in San Diego County. Pete Verboom moved his family from San Diego county to Orland and in 2001 and built a beautiful new dairy. In 2002, Pete Verboom decided to sell his dairy and end the dairy business.

Pete was a thoughtful Orland community member and contributed financially to help build Providence Christian School, as well as an assisted living facility, West Haven.

Pete also rebuilt the old Murdock School, which is a part of the property for sale. Murdock School has been around since the early 1900s, when it first opened on February 10, 1919, to serve the children of settlers west of Orland. The first schoolhouse was burned and another was built in the same location. The 1921 attendance was 36 students. Murdock School closed in 1944, with Lois Morrison as its last teacher.
