

ATTENTION CRP LANDOWNERS!

DO YOU WANT TO EARN ADDITIONAL INCOME ON YOUR PROPERTY?

Nebraska is more than 97% privately owned, and obtaining access to private lands is a major challenge facing today's hunters. The Nebraska Game & Parks Commission (NGPC) and Lower Loup Natural Resources District (LLNRD) are now offering landowners up to **\$16.00 per acre** for CRP lands enrolled in the Open Fields and Waters (OFW) Program. OFW is a voluntary program that provides landowners with annual payments for allowing walk-in hunting access on their properties.

Advantages to the landowner:

1. Earn annual payments of up to \$16.00 per acre (up to \$8.00 from NGPC AND up to \$8.00 from LLNRD) for CRP lands
2. Liability protection provided through the Nebraska Recreation Liability Act

Other things to know:

1. Hunters are allowed WALK-IN access only – NO VEHICLES are allowed
2. Boundary signs are posted around OFW properties by NGPC staff
3. Walk-in access is allowed during all hunting/trapping seasons
4. Properties are listed in the Nebraska Public Access Atlas
5. Landowner participation has grown substantially (+138,000 acres since 2016)
