

975± Acres Dimmit Co. Hwy. 277 Carrizo Springs, Texas







DESCRIPTION

This ranch is located in the heart of big deer country and also provides premier habitat for quail with primarily sandy soils and motted brush. It is not often you have the opportunity to buy a ranch with this combination in Dimmit County, as not many of them come up for sale. Owned and operated by the same family since the early 1900's this ranch is set up with a great road system, very usable improvements, good distribution of water and plenty of paved road frontage.

IMPROVEMENTS

The main house has been totally remodeled and has 4 bedrooms, 3 bathrooms, a large kitchen, dining room, living area, and a scenic back deck that overlooks a nice pond. Next to the main house is a $2,700\pm$ square foot insulated, concrete floored barn joining a $2,000\pm$ square foot covered shed. The barn has easy drive-through roll top doors on either end. The property is high-fenced on 3 sides, with the west fence being standard height field fencing.

WATER

The ranch is well watered with 3 ponds and 2 currently active water wells. The pond at the main house is supplemented by a water well and is stocked with catfish and bass. There are several troughs throughout.



WILDLIFE

This area is known for producing large whitetail deer and this property has everything in place to grow them. Along with deer are turkey, Blue and Bob White Quail, dove, javelina varmints and more.







VEGETATION/SOILS

The ranch has all the necessary browse and brush species to grow large whitetail deer. The primarily sandy soils covered in native grasses with motted brush is the ideal habitat to support and hunt quail. Brush species includes but is not limited to Guajillo, Black brush, Guayacan, White Brush, Prickley Pear, Brazil, Persimmon, Granjeno, Lotebush, Catclaw, Texas persimmon, Vine Ephedra, Forestiera, Hogplum, Cenizo, Lantana, Wolfberry, Tasajillo, Palo Verde and Wooly Bucket Bumelia. This ranch has an impressive stand of native grasses and offers great livestock grazing opportunities as well as hunting.
