All that certain 10.00 acre tract of land in the Thos, B. King Survey, A – 469, in Hamilton County. Texas, being a part of that certain 15.00 acre tract described in deed from Dan Zelios to Matthew Cummins, dated March 20, 2018, and recorded in volume 533, page 110 of the official public records of Hamilton County, Texas, and described as follows:

Beginning at a 3/8" iron rod found the southwest corner of the said 15.00 acre tract, in the north line of a 458.07 acre tract described in deed from Virginia E. England to Morning Star Family. L.P., dated January 24, 2003, and recorded in volume 355, page 362 of the official public records of Hamilton County, Texas, and in the south line of the said King Survey, for the southwest corner of this tract:

Thence N 30°33'58" W, along the west line of the said 15.00 acre tract and crossing Hamilton County Road No. 119, 566.30' to the northwest corner of this tract, from which a 4" pipe post bears N 32° 11' 44" W, 27.44';

Thence N 59°12'05" E, along the north line of the said 15.00 acre tract and the center of said county road, 768.93' to the northeast corner of this tract:

Thence S 30° 33' 32" E, crossing the said 15.00 acre tract, 566.90' to a capped 3/8" iron rod set in the south line of the said 15.00 acre tract, the north line of the said 458.07 acre tract, for the southeast corner of this tract:

Thence S 59° 14' 47" W, along the south line of the said 15.00 acre tract and generally north of a fence, 768.86' to the point of beginning and containing 10.00 acres of land.
