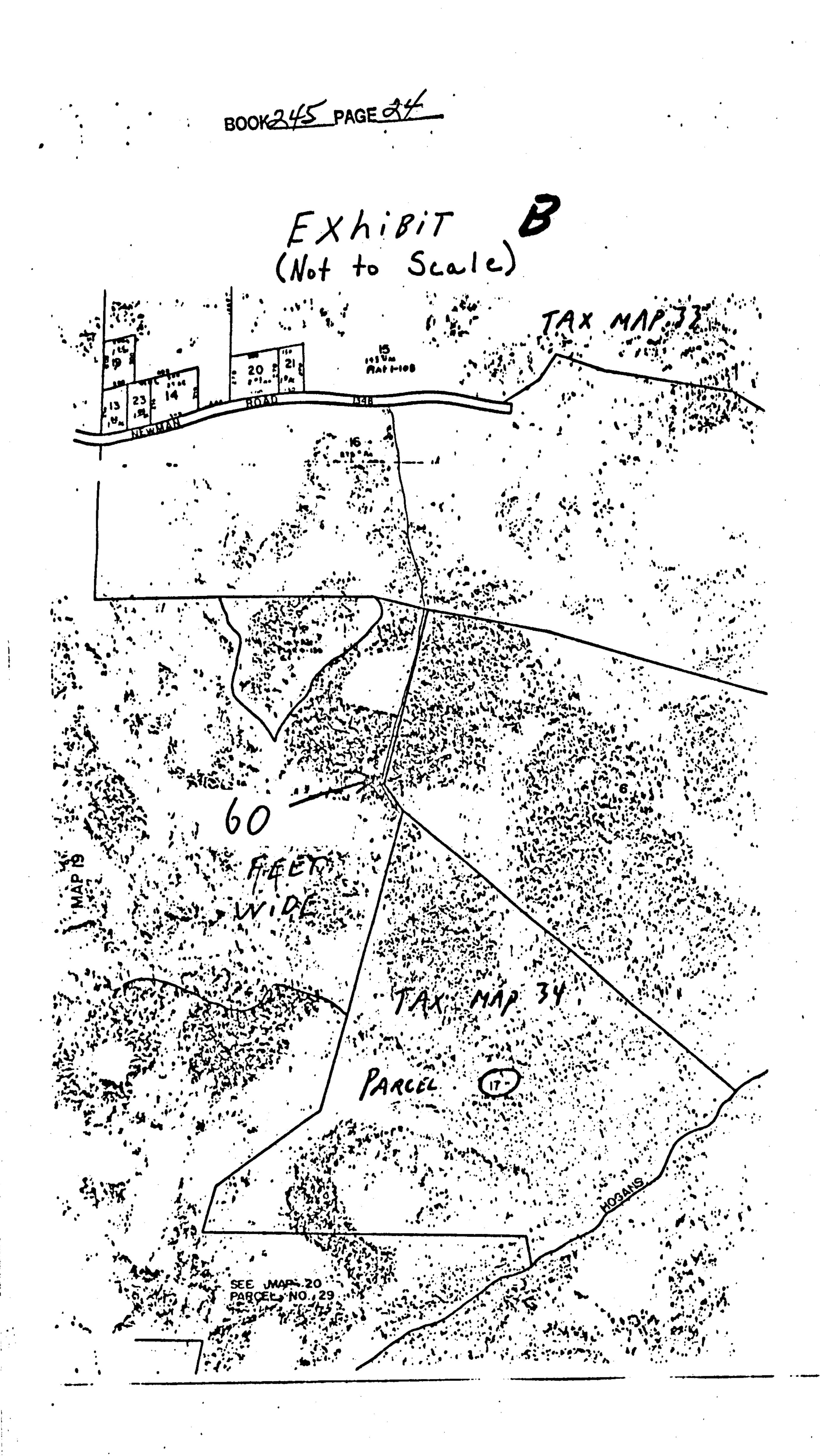

The Easement hereby conveyed on the hereinafter described real property is a perpetual, non-exclusive, alienable and releaseable Easement for ingress and egress across the hereinafter described real property and within the hereinafter described real property in the right on, over, and under the ground to erect, maintain and use electric and telephone poles, wires, cables, conduits, sewage and water mains, and other suitable equipment for the conveyance of electricity, telephones, television cable facilities, gas, sewage, water and other public conveniences or utilities on, in, or over the hereinafter described real property.

The property subject to the hereinabove described Easement is described as follows:

TRACT I

All that certain perpetual right-of-way, containing 1.88 acres, leading from State Road No. 1348 in Pelham Township, Caswell County, North Carolina to the lands of P. Elree Loftis and wife Doris M. Loftis; said perpetual right-of-way being more particularly described and depicted according to plat of survey for P. Elree Loftis dated June 29, 1987, by William Conway Moorefield which plat of survey is duly recorded in the Caswell County, N. C. Registry in Map Book 10 on Page 703 and is by reference incorporated herein as a part of this description.

TRACT II

A SIXTY (60) foot wide strip of land extending from the side of the hereinabove described TRACT I around and along the Northwest property line of Tract 10 as shown and described on the plat of survey recorded in Map Book 4, Page 135 until you reach the property line of Tract # 11 as shown and described on the Plat of Survey recorded in Map Book 1, Page 42 and 42A and Map Book 2, Page 133 (approximate distance and direction would be 1088.85 feet--South 19 deg. 47 min. 30 sec. West; thence South 30 deg. 56 min West 157 feet; thence South 43 deg. 06 min East to the property line of Tract # 11 as shown and described on the Plat of Survey recorded in Map Book 1, Page 42 and 42A and Map Book 2, Page 133).

The approximate location of this part of the Easement is shown on Exhibit A (*NOT TO SCALE*) which is a composite of information contained on the Plat recorded in Map Book 10, Page 703 and Map Book 4, Page 135. The description located thereon is hereby incorporated into this description by reference.

The location of TRACT II is also drawn in on Exhibit B ("NOT TO SCALE") which is a composite of Tax Map 33 and Tax Map 34. The description located thereon is hereby incorporated into this description by reference.

The hereinabove described TRACT II is also described as Lot 8-C (containing 1.789 acres) plus another undesignated tract of land containing 0.124 acres for a total of 1.913 acres. These two (2) tracts of land are shown and described on the Plat of Survey recorded in Map Book 6, Page 255, Caswell County Registry. The description located thereon is hereby incorporated into this description by reference.

For the record, EVELYN NEWNAM WATKINS died in Flordia and her husband, HENRY M. WATKINS, inherited all of her property. When HENRY M. WATKINS died in Flordia, his then spouse, ELIZABETH B. WATKINS, inherited all of his property. ELIZABETH B. WATKINS, Widow of HENRY M. 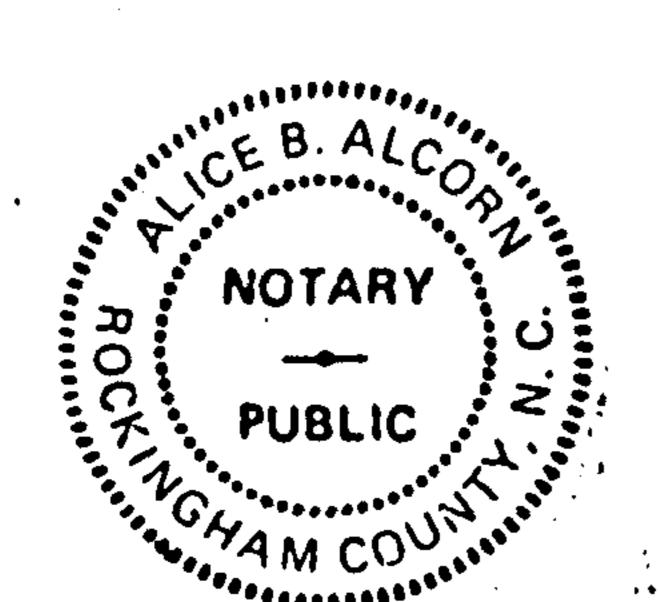

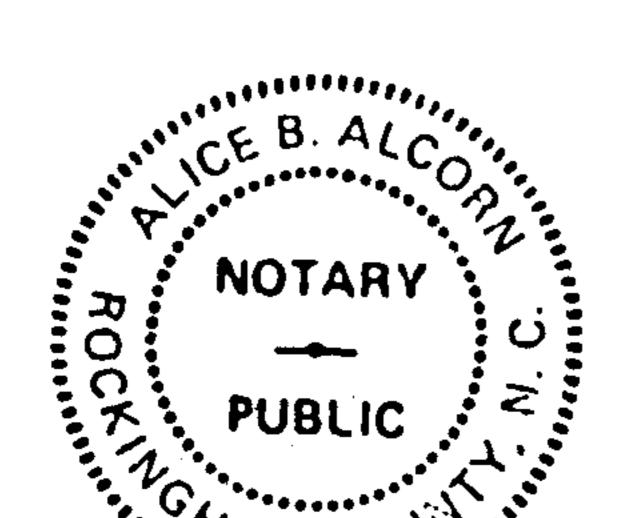

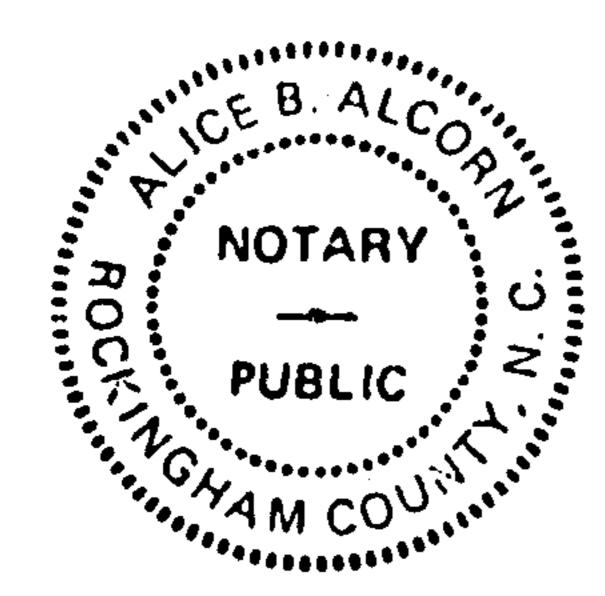
