

The topography on the property slopes from front to back. The is an approximately 40-acre pine tree plantation on the front of the ranch. The remainder of the ranch has thick hardwood cover with a small duck pond in the back.

The property has been left very thick and utilized primarily as a hunting place. There is an old septic system and power on the front of property that can be utilized for a hunting camp. Deer and hogs are frequent to the property with duck hunting described as great in season.


















Location

North Creek Ranch is very well located being about halfway between Centerville, Texas and Crockett, Texas off Highway 7.


I-45 is the main north south interstate with Dallas and Houston each about 2 hours away. Centerville has great restaurants, multiple gas stations, and a very neat downtown area.




Remarks


