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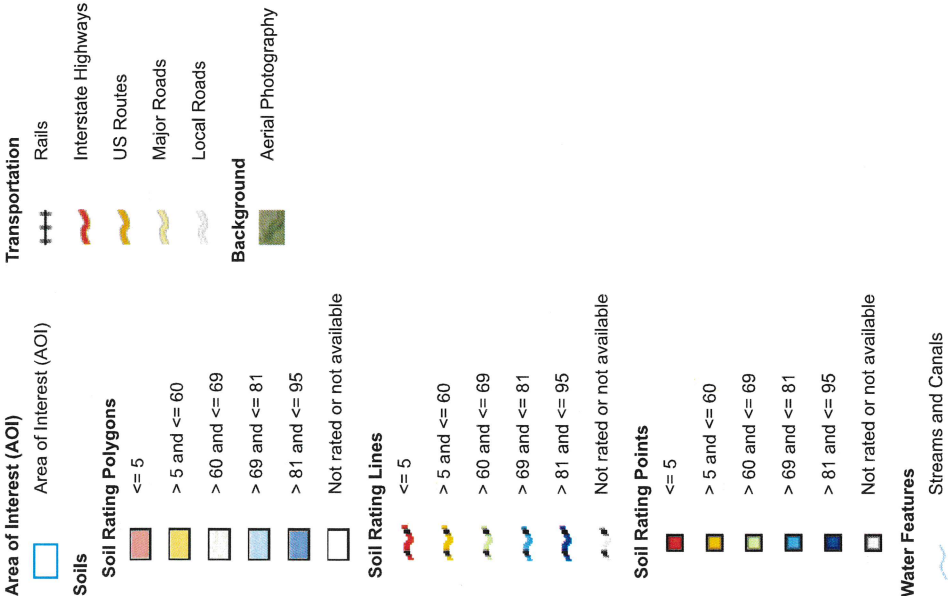
Iowa Corn Suitability Rating CSR2 (IA)—Pottawattamie County, Iowa
